- State Governor's Stay At Home Order
  - April 26<sup>th</sup>
- Local Emergency Declaration
  - April 17<sup>th</sup>
  - Second extension this evening



### NORTHGLENN IS PREPARED

- All City facilities closed until further notice following State guidance
- City's Emergency Operation Center Activated in early March
- Continued daily coordination with Adams County Office of Emergency Management
- City continues to provide essential services



# Six Feet Away GOVID-19 AND MINIMIZING RISK



COVID-19 is primarily spread through respiratory droplets produced when an infected person coughs or sneezes.






