CITY OF NORTHGLENN NOTICE OF PUBLIC HEARING 2009/2010 COMMUNITY DEVELOPMENT BLOCK GRANT PROGRAM

On December 10, 2009, the City Council of the City of Northglenn will hold a public hearing on the use of the city's 2009 and 2010 Community Development Block Grant funds. The public hearing will be held during the City Council meeting that will begin at 7:00 p.m. in City Hall Council Chambers, 11701 Community Center Drive.

Approximately \$150,000 in 2009 CDBG funds and \$200,000 in 2010 funds is available to the City for eligible projects. Anyone who would like to address City Council concerning use of CDBG funds is invited to attend the public hearing.

In order to be eligible for funding, projects must address one of the following national objectives:

- 1. Benefits low- and moderate-income persons: or
- 2. Prevention or elimination of slums or blighted areas; or
- 3. The activity address urgent community development needs such as a situation declared a national or state disaster.

The proposed projects are not intended to replace local funding for routine governmental services or for community development activities already being funded locally. It is proposed that the available 2009 and 2010 CDBG funds should be used to pay for pedestrian mobility improvements in low income neighborhoods and to continue the Help for Homes program which provides grants for critical home improvements to low income home owners.
