SUBJECT:	Citizen Inquiry/Standing Water I-25 Pedestrian Underpass (CDOT Right-of-Way)

## **BACKGROUND:**

On June 17, 2009, City staff contacted the Colorado Department of Transportation (CDOT) regarding standing water on the walkway of the I-25 Pedestrian Underpass just south of 120<sup>th</sup> Avenue. In response to the City's query, CDOT personnel visited the site to investigate the situation. On July 7, 2009, CDOT sent an email to the City of Northglenn notifying staff that the standing water in the underpass is due to seepage and that CDOT had no plans for any corrective actions.

On August 17, 2009 City staff again contacted CDOT regarding the standing water on the walkway of the I-25 Pedestrian Underpass in response to the comments made by a citizen at the August 13<sup>th</sup> City Council meeting. Staff requested a meeting with CDOT staff to visit the site and discuss the situation. Staff is currently waiting for a response.
