A RESOLUTION DIRECTING THE CITY MANAGER TO EVALUATE THE COST EFFECTIVENESS OF CITY SERVICES

WHEREAS, the City continues to look at different ways to provide the best services at the least cost to the residents of the City of Northglenn;

WHEREAS, the City of Northglenn Charter Review Committee recommended that the City Council consider putting all services out to bid on a regular basis as a method of assuring that services are provided at the least cost;

WHEREAS, the City Council desires to have the City Manager analyze whether certain City functions and services can be delivered more efficiently and at less cost without necessarily requiring that all City services be put out to bid at regular intervals.

BE IT RESOLVED BY THE CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF NORTHGLENN, COLORADO, THAT:

Section 1. The City Manager is hereby directed as part of the budget process commencing with the 2010 budget process to provide the City Council with a proposal regarding how best to analyze on a City-wide basis providing the highest quality municipal services at the least cost to the City residents. Such a proposal should include, but not be limited to, the following elements:

- A. A schedule for assessing the provision of services by the City on a department by department basis, with the goal of providing the highest quality municipal services at the least cost to the City residents; and
- B. A recommendation regarding whether a mandatory bid process for certain services is the best way to provide the highest quality municipal services at the least cost to City residents.
