SUBJECT: CR 09-85 Northglenn Municipal V.A.L.E. Grant Acceptance

RECOMMENDATION:

Attached to this memorandum is a Resolution which, if approved, would accept a grant in the amount of \$9,725.00 from Northglenn Municipal Victim Assistance and Law Enforcement ("V.A.L.E.") Board. Staff recommends approval of the proposed Resolution.

BACKGROUND:

The Police Department applies for grants from a variety of funding sources to fully fund or supplement our operations and to purchase needed equipment. The V.A.L.E. Grant associated with this Resolution will fund the following: Purchase five Glock training pistols, 20 protective helmets, and ten cases of Simunition ammunition. This equipment and these supplies will be used to provide realistic armed encounter training without live ammunition dangers. Simunitions are low velocity plastic bullets containing a colored liquid (similar to paint balls) that are fired from specially designed Glock training firearms that allows officers to simulate real combat scenarios in a non-lethal environment.

BUDGET IMPLICATIONS:

The 2009 Police Department Budget does not include moneys for this equipment. These funds are will be transferred within the 2009 General Fund Budget from V.A.L.E. to the Police Department.
