NOTICE OF PUBLIC HEARING
2009 COMMUNITY DEVELOPMENT BLOCK GRANT PROGRAM**

On August 28, 2008, the City Council of the City of Northglenn will hold a public hearing on the use of the city's 2009 Community Development Block Grant funding. The public hearing will be held during the City Council meeting that will begin at 7:00 p.m. in City Hall Council Chambers, 11701 Community Center Drive.

Approximately \$200,000 is anticipated to be available to the City for eligible projects during 2009. Anyone who would like to address City Council concerning possible projects for 2009 is invited to attend the public hearing.

In order to be eligible for funding, projects must address one of the following national objectives:

1. Benefits low- and moderate-income persons; or
2. Prevention or elimination of slums or blighted areas; or
3. The activity address urgent community development needs such as a situation declared a national or state disaster.

The proposed projects are not intended to replace local funding for routine governmental services or for community development activities already being funded locally. It is proposed that City's 2009 CDBG funding should be used as follows:

- Malley cross-walk improvement project
- Larson Drive cross-walk improvement project
