Designation

RECOMMENDATION:

Attached to this memorandum is a Resolution, which if approved, designates approximately \$200,000 in Community Development Block Grant (CDBG) Funds for the 2009 program year for crosswalk improvements on Malley Drive/Farmers Highline Canal and 112th Avenue/Larson Drive. Staff recommends approval of the proposed Resolution.

BACKGROUND:

On July 17 and August 7, 2008, staff presented information to the City Council regarding CDBG funds for the 2009 program year. Mr. Bill Sullivan, Executive Director of the Northglenn Neighborhood Development Corporation (NNDC) was invited to speak at the study session on August 7. Extensive discussion was held about the organization and the Council generally agreed to designate \$200,000 in CDBG funds for crosswalk improvements in 2009.

BUDGET/TIME IMPLICATIONS:

There are no direct budget implications since CDBG funds are granted to the City from Adams County. The 2009 program year begins March 1, 2009 and ends February 28, 2010. However, final grant applications and an approved resolution by the City Council are due to Adams County Office of Community Department no later than September 8, 2008.

A RESOLUTION DESIGNATING THE 2009 COMMUNITY DEVELOPMENT BLOCK GRANT PROJECTS

WHEREAS, the City receives Community Development Block Grant (CDBG) funds from Adams County pursuant to an Intergovernmental Agreement for undertaking community development and housing assistance activities; and

WHEREAS, the City Council has recommended that all of the City's 2009 CDBG funding, which is currently estimated to be approximately \$200,000, be used for crosswalk improvements at Malley and Farmers Highline Canal Trail and at 112th and Larson Drive; and

WHEREAS, the City Council conducted a public hearing regarding the use of the City's 2009 CDBG funding on August 28, 2008.

BE IT RESOLVED BY THE CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF NORTHGLENN, COLORADO, THAT:

Section 1. The City Council hereby designates that all of the City's 2009 CDBG funding allocation be used for crosswalk improvements at the intersection of Malley Drive and the Farmers Highline Canal and at the intersection of 112th Avenue and Larson Drive.
