2007 Community Development Block Grant Program

On May 22nd, 2008, the City Council of the City of Northglenn, Colorado will hold a public hearing on the re-designation of a portion of the City's 2007 Community Development Block Grant (CDBG) funding. The public hearing will be held during the City Council meeting that will begin at 7:00 p.m. in City Hall Council Chambers, 11701 Community Center Drive.

There is \$91,000 available to the City for eligible projects. Anyone who would like to address City Council concerning possible projects for these funds is invited to attend the public hearing.

In order to be eligible for funding, projects must address one of the following national objectives:

- 1. The activity principally benefits low/moderate income residents;
- 2. The activity aids in the prevention or elimination of slums or blight;
- 3. The activity addresses urgent community development needs such as a situation declared a national emergency.

The proposed use of the funds is not intended to replace local funding for routine governmental services or for community development activities already being funded locally. It is proposed that \$91,000 of the City's 2007 CDBG be used to fund the Equity IQ Program which will create a program for the acquisition and preservation of affordable housing through the purchase and rehabilitation of homes in the City of Northglenn.
