Neighborhood Clean Up Program: Roll-off Containers

BACKGROUND

Approximately fifteen (15) years ago the City of Northglenn began a program for Neighborhood Watch Groups to have roll off containers delivered to the neighborhood in an effort to keep areas clean and safe. The City of Northglenn would like to expand the program to include resident groups. Residents who create a group of at least five (5) separate residences wanting to participate in the cleanup may have a roll-off container delivered on Friday, and the pickup on the following Monday.

Reservations would be taken on a "first come, first serve" basis. One member of the group would need to be point of contact, complete the form, submit the request, and agree to the terms and conditions of use.

This proposal was previously brought forth for discussion at the City Council study session on August 4, 2014.

BUDGET/TIME IMPLICATIONS

Staff does not believe that these changes to the existing Neighborhood Clean-up Program will have any significant impact to Sanitation Division funding.

RECOMMENDATION

Attached to this memorandum is a Resolution that, if approved, would allow the City Manager to implement the Neighborhood Cleanup Program for the delivery of roll-off containers to groups of residents that agree to the terms and conditions of the program.

Staff recommends approval of this Resolution.
