A RESOLUTION CALLING A SPECIAL ELECTION TO BE HELD ON NOVEMBER 4, 2014, DIRECTING THAT SAID SPECIAL ELECTION BE COORDINATED WITH ADAMS AND WELD COUNTIES, RESPECTIVELY, AND REFERRING A BALLOT QUESTION TO THE REGISTERED ELECTORS OF THE CITY AT SAID SPECIAL ELECTION

WHEREAS, Section 2.3 of the City of Northglenn Home Rule Charter permits the calling of a special municipal election by resolution or ordinance of the City Council at least forty-five (45) days prior to the election.

THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED BY THE CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF NORTHGLENN, COLORADO, THAT:

Section 1. The City Council hereby calls a special election to be held on November 4, 2014.

<u>Section 2</u>. At the special election to be held on November 4, 2014, the following ballot question shall be submitted to the registered electors of the City of Northglenn:

QUESTION NO. \_\_\_: (MARIJUANA SALES TAX)

SHALL CITY OF NORTHGLENN TAXES BE INCREASED BY FOUR HUNDRED FIFTY THOUSAND DOLLARS (\$450,000) ANNUALLY IN THE FIRST FISCAL YEAR, AND BY SUCH AMOUNTS AS ARE RAISED ANNUALLY THEREAFTER BY IMPOSING A NEW SALES TAX OF TWO PERCENT (2%) ON THE SALE OF RETAIL MARIJUANA AND MEDICAL MARIJUANA, AND RETAIL MARIJUANA AND MEDICAL MARIJUANA PRODUCTS, WHICH SHALL BE IN ADDITION TO THE MUNICIPAL SALES TAX ON SUCH SALES, AND SHALL ALL REVENUES DERIVED FROM SUCH TAX BE COLLECTED AND SPENT TO BE USED EXCLUSIVELY FOR THE CONSTRUCTION OF PUBLIC FACILITIES, INCLUDING, BUT NOT LIMITED TO, THE NORTHGLENN RECREATION CENTER, THE NORTHGLENN CITY HALL, THE NORTHGLENN POLICE DEPARTMENT, AND THE NORTHGLENN SENIOR CENTER AS A VOTER APPROVED REVENUE CHANGE WITHOUT REGARD TO ANY EXPENDITURE, REVENUE RAISING, OR **OTHER** LIMITATION CONTAINED IN ARTICLE X, § 20 OF THE COLORADO CONSTITUTION OR ANY OTHER LAW?
