

PROCLAMATION

WHEREAS, the Sock It To Em sock campaign was launched in Denver in 2011 and has

spread to cities throughout the United States aiming to cover the feet of as

many of those in need as possible before each new year; and

WHEREAS, socks are the number one clothing need of the homeless, as they wear out

faster than any other article of clothing, and are rarely donated; and

WHEREAS, the Sock It To Em sock campaign kicked off its fourth annual effort to

provide warm socks to those without permanent shelter on Thanksgiving Day, November 27, 2014, and will collect donated socks through

December 31, 2014; and

WHEREAS, the Sock It To Em sock campaign has designated December 10, 2014 as

Sock It To Em Workday, a day when our residents are asked to forego wearing their socks as a show of support for the homeless, and to

recognize the great need for warm socks for those in need; and

WHEREAS, the City of Northglenn fully and strongly supports this effort and

encourages our residents to participate by going to work sockless and by

donating socks for the homeless.

NOW THEREFORE I, Joyce Downing, Mayor of the City of Northglenn, Colorado, do hereby proclaim December 10, 2014 as:

SOCK IT TO EM WORKDAY

in the City of Northglenn and encourage all of our residents to doff their socks on December 10, 2014, and donate socks for the homeless from now through December 31, 2014.
