A RESOLUTION MAKING FINDINGS OF FACT IN SUPPORT OF THE DECISION TO GRANT A RETAIL MARIJUANA STORE LICENSE TO PHYSICIAN PREFERRED PRODUCTS LLC, d/b/a PHYSICIAN PREFERRED PRODUCTS

WHEREAS, the City Council of the City of Northglenn acting as the City's Retail Marijuana Local Licensing Authority conducted a hearing on the request by Applicant Physician Preferred Products, LLC d/b/a Physician Preferred Products ("Applicant") for a new Retail Marijuana Store License to be located at 2100 E. 112th Avenue, #5, Northglenn, Colorado 80233 on January 13, 2014, pursuant to C.R.S. § 12-43.4-302 and Article 16 of Chapter 18 of the Northglenn Municipal Code;

WHEREAS, the City Council at the January 13, 2014 hearing took evidence and heard arguments regarding the qualifications of the Applicant and the criteria set forth in Section 18-16-7 of the Northglenn Municipal Code; and

WHEREAS, after hearing the evidence, hearing arguments, and deliberating on the evidence, the City Council directed in accordance with Section 3-7-11 of the Northglenn Municipal Code that findings of fact be drafted to grant a Retail Marijuana Store License to Applicant, thereby authorizing a dual operation within the meaning of Article 16 of Chapter 18 of the Northglenn Municipal Code.

BE IT RESOLVED BY THE CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF NORTHGLENN, COLORADO, THAT:

<u>Section 1</u>. The recitals set forth above are hereby incorporated herein by this reference.

Section 2. The City Council hereby makes the following findings of fact:

- A. The members and agents of Applicant are not prohibited as licensees pursuant to Section 18-16-14 of the Northglenn Municipal Code;
- B. The location of the licensed premises complies with Section 18-16-13 of the Northglenn Municipal Code;
- C. The evidence presented at the hearing showed that the number, type and availability of medical marijuana outlets and other pertinent factors as set forth in the Colorado Retail Marijuana Code, C.R.S. § 12-43.4-101, *et seq.*, and Article 16 of Chapter 18 of the Northglenn Municipal Code did not preclude the issuance of a license to Applicant pursuant to Section 18-16-7 of the Northglenn Municipal Code; and
