

A BILL FOR AN ORDINANCE AMENDING SECTION 16-1-2 OF THE NORTHGLENN MUNICIPAL CODE REGARDING THE REMOVAL OF SNOW AND ICE FROM SIDEWALKS

BE IT ORDAINED BY THE CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF NORTHGLENN, COLORADO, THAT:

Section 1. Section 16-1-2 of the Northglenn Municipal Code is amended to read as follows:

Section 16-1-2. Removal of Snow and Ice from Sidewalks

(a) Every person, partnership, corporation, jointstock company or syndicate in charge or control of any building, or lot of land within the City fronting or abutting on a paved sidewalk, whether as owner, tenant, occupant, lessee, or otherwise, shall remove and clear away, or cause to be removed and cleared away, snow and ice from so much of said sidewalk as is in front of or abuts on said building or lot of land, within forty-eight (48) hours after the cessation of any fall of snow, sleet or freezing rain. PROVIDED HOWEVER, IN THE EVENT OF UNUSUAL OR EXTRAORDINARY WEATHER CIRCUMSTANCES, THE CITY MANAGER IS AUTHORIZED TO PROVIDE AN EXTENSION OF A REASONABLE TIME IN WHICH TO CLEAR THE SNOW AND ICE FROM SAID SIDEWALK.


(b) In the event snow and ice on a sidewalk has become so hard that it cannot be removed without likelihood of damage to the sidewalk, the person or entity charged with its removal shall, within forty-eight (48) hours after the cessation of any fall of snow, sleet or freezing rain, cause enough sand or other abrasive to be put on the sidewalk to make travel thereon reasonably safe, and shall then, as soon thereafter as weather permits, cause said sidewalk to be thoroughly cleaned.

(c) As used in this Section 16-1-2, the term "**sidewalk**" means that portion of a street between the curb lines, or the lateral lines of a roadway, and the adjacent property lines, intended for the use of pedestrians.


