State Enterprise Zone Program

Additionally staff sent out notifications to Northglenn businesses located in the Enterprise Zone (EZ) to:

- Inform new businesses that they were recently incorporated into the EZ, and on the credits that are available through the program; and
- Remind existing companies to take advantage of the EZ program, and to inform them on the new EZ legislation that was passed in July that requires pre-certification prior to **December 31, 2011**.

During December five new companies turned in 2011 EZ certifications, and 12 companies precertified for credits for 2012.

\$25,000 Awarded by NURA for Businesses Improvements

The Northglenn Urban Renewal Authority (NURA) developed a Business Improvement Grant (BIG) program that offers up to \$12,500 in matching funds to commercial businesses in the NURA boundary areas. The program was started in October to make exterior improvements to properties such as façades, roofing, windows; signs (new, repairs, replacements, removal); landscaping; and parking lot upgrades and repairs.

In December NURA approved the following two matching Business Improvement Grants (BIG).

- The Summit Group, property manager for the Metro North Building located at 11990 Grant Street applied for a \$12,500 NURA grant to assist in the cost to resurface the existing parking lot. The total project cost is \$130,585.
- Northglenn Greens Holdings, owners and property manager for the Northglenn Greens Park located at 104th & Bannock Street applied for a \$12,500 NURA grant. The total project cost is \$25,208 for a new marquee sign located at the southwest corner of the property to promote and market the companies.

In 2012, NURA has budgeted for up to \$100,000 under the BIG program for other qualifying projects.

NURA Updates

NURA is taking a proactive role in branding and marketing. They have recently adopted the below logo to be used on NURA-related projects and materials:



Additionally, the following new website domain (URL) has been implemented to market NURA: <u>www.NorthglennUrbanRenewal.org</u>. This URL points to the NURA page on the Northglenn website.

Also, three large signs have been ordered to be used to promote NURA and Northglenn redevelopment projects. These signs are reusable, and can be customized with the developer/company logos. They will be placed in strategic locations as projects occur.

The NURA website and the monthly Northglenn Connection feature *Frequently Asked Questions* to help educate and provide a better understanding of the program and types of projects under urban renewal authorities.

Count the Lights Contest

The annual *Count the Lights Contest* at the Marketplace was very successful. Cash prizes of \$1,500 were awarded, with approximately an additional \$500 in Marketplace gift certificates. NURA provided \$1,000 in cash prizes. We had almost three times the contest entries as in 2010. This is an indicator of increased traffic and sales at Marketplace retailers. Staff worked with Commissioner Wayne Dodge to promote the contest, get retailer gift certificates, coordinate the liability insurance, and get the prizes distributed to the winners. This was a good opportunity for staff to meet with several of the participating retailers (Cinzetti's, Mountain Man, Lowe's Atlanta Bread, Al's Former Wear, and Woodley's).

Unemployment

The table below shows November 2011 estimated labor force, employment and unemployment information. The state, county and Northglenn's unemployment **rate increased by.1%** over last October's numbers.

New Northglenn Businesses

The city is pleased to welcome the following new companies and organizations to Northglenn that were reported in December.

Crossroads American Baptist Church (Go Serve) leased 2,350 square feet at 10530 Huron Street (former Rangeview Library District-1st floor) to serve as a food bank and community outreach center. They have one employee and several volunteers at the site. Xhaust Pipes, LLC leased 2,622 square feet at 10650 Irma Drive, Unit 7. The company relocated from Federal Heights, and provides muffler, exhaust, and catalytic converter services for motorcycles, recreational vehicles, and automobiles. They employ 3 people.
