## **PURPOSE**

Update City Council on the planning to celebrate the City's 50<sup>th</sup> anniversary which takes place in 2019.

#### **BACKGROUND**

The City of Northglenn will turn 50 years old in April of 2019. An employee committee has been formed to plan a year-long celebration. Possible ideas include the following:

- Proclamation and kick-off event (such as dedicating a trail on Earth Day in April)
- History: Involve Historical Commission; honor past mayors and council members
- Themed celebrations in conjunction with existing events and activities (for example: 50ft. ice cream sundae or birthday cake on Community Center Drive during July 4<sup>th</sup> event or the planting of a commemorative flower bed)
- Features in print publications: Connection and Northglenn-Thornton Sentinel
- Communications pieces such as video, printed materials, timeline, light pole banners
- Encourage community participation via social media (such as #NGProud) for posting photos and memories

The committee will meet throughout the second half of the year to finalize the plan, further develop a budget, and implement the celebration.
