
Procedure for Creating Urban Renewal Area

- Determine survey area boundaries
- Notify property owners within boundaries
- Verify presence and location of "blighted" conditions (field survey)
- Prepare conditions survey
- Present survey findings to urban renewal entity and council for <u>acceptance</u> *
- Define boundaries for urban renewal area (may be the same as conditions survey boundary)
- Complete market analysis
- Together with stakeholders define future role of area in community
- Prepare urban renewal plan
- Complete financial analysis (tax increment finance TIF)
- Complete impact analysis for impacted taxing bodies
- Present urban renewal plan to urban renewal entity and council for <u>adoption</u>
- Work with owners and developers to determine possibilities for redevelopment
- Implement plan
- * Presentation to Council may occur in conjunction with presentation of final urban renewal plan



Survey Area

- 244 parcels
- 350 acres
- 121 parcels in Urban Renewal Plan
 No. 1 (243.93 acres)
- 113 new parcels added (55.41 acres)
- 7 parcels in Huron Center (16.39 acres)
- 14 developed parcels (77.75 acres)




Plan Consideration (Council Executive Session)

- Two urban renewal plan
 - Urban Renewal Plan No. 1 as amended
 - Urban Renewal Plan No. 2
- Urban Renewal Plan No. 1 multiple TIF districts
 - Developed Parcels (including Marketplace)
 - Huron
 - Adopt Urban Renewal Plan No. 2 without any TIFs
 - Amend Plan No. 2 as new TIFs come on-line
- Marketplace, Huron and other developed parcels will remain part of Urban Renewal Plan No. 1 and their

TIFs will run out through 2017
