Business Marketing & Promotional Packet

NURA Updating Urban Renewal Plan

The Northglenn Urban Renewal Authority (NURA) is updating its current Urban Renewal Plan. It has retained the professional services of Ricker-Cunningham to complete the survey. The goal of the survey is to study properties both within current Northglenn urban renewal areas (URA), adjacent properties, and new areas to determine if conditions meet the state URA designation requirements under the Colorado Urban Renewal Statute. The NURA board and staff have developed a proactive public informational and outreach program to ensure that property owners, stakeholders and citizens have the opportunity to ask questions and provide input during the process. A public information meeting is being coordinated and will be scheduled in August. The area map is attached to this report (Exhibit A) detailing the properties being studied.
