GENERAL FUND IN THE AMOUNT OF \$414,432 AND TO INCREASE APPROPRIATIONS IN THE GENERAL FUND IN THE AMOUNT OF \$529,344 REQUIRED TO COMPLETE FUNDING OF THE YEAR 2006

GREENWAY TRAILS PROJECT.

ADDITIONAL EXPLANATORY REMARKS:

THE APPROPRIATED DOLLARS WILL FUND REMOVAL AND REPLACEMENT OF EXISTING ASPHALT GREENWAY TRAIL ALONG 104TH AVENUE FROM THE WEST CITY LIMITS TO HURON STREET (5,311 FEET OF 10' TRAIL), WYCO PARK (5,079 FEET OF 8' TRAIL), AND J.D. CAYTON PARK (960 FEET OF 8' TRAIL). THIS IS A TOTAL OF 11,351 FEET OF TRAIL REPLACED OR 2.14 MILES. IN ADDITION. LANDSCAPING AND IRRIGATION WILL BE INSTALLED ALONG THE 104TH AVENUE TRAIL TO ENHANCE THE APPEARANCE OF THE CORRIDOR. THE TOTAL ESTIMATED COST FOR THIS PROJECT IS \$1,185,092. THE CITY RECEIVED A GRANT FROM ADAMS COUNTY OPEN SPACE IN THE AMOUNT OF \$214,610. THE REMAINING BALANCE WILL BE PAID FOR THROUGH A COMBINATION OF ADAMS COUNTY OPEN SPACE TAX, CONSERVATION TRUST, AND GENERAL FUND REVENUES.

BE IT ORDAINED BY THE CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF NORTHGLENN, COLORADO, THAT THE 2006 BUDGET SHALL BE AMENDED AS FOLLOWS:

- Section 1. Supplemental appropriations, transfer of appropriations and recognition of revenues.
 - (a) <u>General Fund.</u> Amend the 2006 General Fund budget to increase estimated revenues in the amount of \$414,432 as follows:

\$214,610 from Adams County Open Space grant awarded 02/01/06. The grant terms specify funding for the purpose of Parks Trail Replacement Program.

\$199,822 from Adams County Open Space tax.

Recognize a increase in the final 2006 General Fund unrestricted fund balance of \$414,432 represented by the above estimated revenues.

(b) General Fund. Amend the 2006 General Fund budget to increase appropriations in the amount of \$529,344 as follows:

\$529,344 for the purpose of additional funding for the 2006 greenway trails projects.

Recognize a decrease in the final 2006 General Fund unrestricted fund balance of \$414,432 represented by the above estimated revenues and \$114,912 represented by unrestricted fund balance.


Recommended Action

Recommend approving the attached ordinance amending the 2006 budget to increase total estimated revenues in the General Fund by \$414,432 and to increase appropriations in the General Fund by \$529,344 to fund the completion of the year 2006 Greenway Trail projects.

Background and Other Information

The appropriated dollars will fund removal and replacement of existing asphalt Greenway Trail along 104th Avenue from the West City Limits to Huron Street (5,311 feet of 10' trail), Wyco Park (5,079 feet of 8' trail), and J.D. Cayton Park (960 feet of 8' trail). This is a total of 11,351 feet of trail replaced or 2.14 miles. In addition, landscaping and irrigation will be installed along the 104th Avenue trail to enhance the appearance of the corridor. The total estimated cost for this project is \$1,185,092. The City received a grant from Adams County Open Space in the amount of \$214,610. The remaining balance will be paid for through a combination of Adams County Open Space Tax, Conservation Trust, and General Fund revenues.



Project Name: Parks Trail Replacement Program

Amount Awarded is equal to 68% of the funded project up to \$214,610.

Applicant's Responsibilities

- The Applicant agrees that any sums received from the Adams County Open Space Sales Tax will be used in accordance with the Open Space Sales Tax Issue passed in November, 1999, and reauthorized in November, 2004 to be extended until December 31, 2026, ("Tax Issue") and in accordance with the submitted Grant Application by the Applicant (Attachment A).
- The Applicant understands that Adams County reserves all rights to reassess the grant award if the grant is found not to be in compliance with the Tax Issue (Attachment B), the Open Space Grant Guidelines (Attachment C), or the Grant Application.
- All documents and records including but not limited to copies of invoices, checks, and land documents requested for the above project shall be kept in accordance with generally accepted accounting principles and available upon request for review by Adams County.
- The Applicant understands that it is responsible for securing the matching or leveraged funds required for completion of the project, and that failure to obtain the required funds for completion of the project will nullify the award of Adams County Open Space funds.



Extent of Agreement

- The terms of this Agreement shall begin upon the date of the grant award, which is the date first set forth below.
- The Applicant agrees not to sell or convey any lands purchased fully or in part with Open Space grant funds, without the written approval of Adams County.
- This Agreement may be amended only by written instrument signed by both
 Adams County and the Applicant.
- Prior to the distribution of Open Space funds, this Agreement may be terminated by the Applicant upon written notice to Adams County.
- An Adams County Open Space Sign will be posted in a prominent place at the project site, unless the project will not have public access.
- In all press releases regarding this project the following statement must be included: "This project was funded in part with proceeds from the Adams County Open Space Sales Tax. The Adams County Open Space Sales Tax was passed by Adams County voters in 1999, and reauthorized in November, 2004 to be extended until December 31, 2026."
