A RESOLUTION RESTRICTING THE EXPENDITURE OF FUNDS RECEIVED FROM THE ADAMS COUNTY TRANSPORTATION TAX TO CAPITAL IMPROVEMENTS, REHABILITATION AND/OR MAINTENANCE WORK THAT PROLONGS THE USEFUL LIFE OF THE STREET UPON WHICH THE EXPENDITURE IS MADE

WHEREAS, on November 6, 2001, the citizens of Adams County approved the extension of a Transportation Sales Tax of one-half of one percent (the "Transportation Tax") to finance roads, bridges, capital improvements, and other roadway infrastructure within Adams County;

WHEREAS, a portion of the Transportation Tax is distributed by Adams County to the municipalities located within Adams County, including the City of Northglenn; and

WHEREAS, the City Council desires to clarify and specify the type of projects upon which the City of Northglenn may expend those Transportation Tax funds received from Adams County.

BE IT RESOLVED BY THE CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF NORTHGLENN, COLORADO, THAT:

Section 1. The City Council hereby directs that Transportation Tax funds shall hereafter only be expended on capital improvements, the rehabilitation of capital improvements, and the maintenance of streets that prolong the useful life of a street. For purposes of this Resolution, a street shall include only the portion of the street traveled upon by vehicular traffic, and those capital improvements that are directly related to the construction of said street, such as curb and gutter and other drainage improvements, but shall not include sidewalks.

Section 2. The City Council further directs that the expenditure of Transportation Tax funds on streetscapes shall hereafter be prohibited.
