Background:

- ➤ In 2004 the City of Northglenn released several Parks Maintenance and Operations personnel. To compensate for the loss of work force staff began to look at alternative ways to accomplish the same work load without hiring additional employees.
- It was determined that outsourcing some of the ROW mowing and perennial bed maintenance may be a good solution and alternative to hiring personnel.
- Staff reviewed all parks related maintenance practices and developed a plan that would allow for ROW mowing and some perennial bed maintenance to be accomplished by outside contract.
- The bid was advertised through all normal means and, although receiving several pre-bid inquiries, only one bidder, American Civil Constructors, submitted a conforming bid.
- Award of this contract will aid staff in their efforts to assure a Clean and Beautiful City while being Fiscally Responsible as established by Council goals.

Budget/Financial Considerations:

- All funds for award of this contract would come out of the 2006 Parks operating budget where sufficient funds have been appropriated.
- > Staff requests that Council approve this contract and expenditure of funds not to exceed \$95,000.00.

Legal Considerations:

Council is within its legal purview to approve this contract.

Policy Considerations:

Approval of this contract will allow the city to cost-effectively maintain public grounds and ROW without increasing personnel.

Recommended Action:

Authorize the Mayor to approve a contract with American Civil Constructors in an amount not to exceed \$95,000.00.

References: References were contacted and favorable reviews were provided by Jefferson County and the City of Lakewood and are attached for your review. Additionally, we have contracted the services of ACC the past two years for similarly related duties and have been pleased with their performance.

AGREEMENT

PROJECT NAME: 2006 NORTHGLENN LANDSCAPE MAINTENANCE CONTRACT

THIS AGREEMENT, made this day of, 20, by and between the City of Northglenn, hereinafter called "CITY", and American Civil Constructors, Inc., hereinafter called "CONTRACTOR".
WITNESSETH: That for and in consideration of the payments and agreements hereinafter mentioned:
1. The CONTRACTOR will commence and complete the project named:
"2006 NORTHGLENN LANDSCAPE MAINTENANCE CONTRACT"

- 2. The CONTRACTOR will furnish all of the materials, supplies, tools, equipment, labor supervision, and other services necessary for the completion of the PROJECT described herein.
- 3. The CONTRACTOR will provide performance and payment bonds and a certificate of insurance naming the City as an additional insured for purposes of said project within <u>10</u> days after the date of the NOTICE OF AWARD.
- 4. The CONTRACTOR agrees to perform all of the WORK described in the CONTRACT DOCUMENTS and comply with the terms therein for the sum NOT TO EXCEED \$ 95,000.00, or as shown in the BID schedule. The CONTRACTOR will commence the work within 7 calendar days after the date of NOTICE TO PROCEED. The CONTRACTOR will complete the work by December 31, 2006, unless the period for completion is extended otherwise by the CONTRACT DOCUMENTS.
 - 5. The term "CONTRACT DOCUMENTS" means and includes all items as set forth in Section 1.01 of the General Conditions.
- 6. The CITY will pay to the CONTRACTOR in the manner and at such times as set forth in the General Conditions such amounts as required by the CONTRACT DOCUMENTS.
- 7. This AGREEMENT shall be binding upon all parties hereto and their respective heirs, executors, administrators, successors, and assigns.

ADDITIONAL PROVISIONS FOR STANDARD CITY SERVICES CONTRACT *

- 1. UNLAWFUL EMPLOYEES, CONTRACTORS AND SUBCONTRACTORS: Contractor shall not knowingly employ or contract with an illegal alien to perform work under this Contract. Contractor shall not knowingly contract with a subcontractor that (a) knowingly employs or contracts with an illegal alien to perform work under this Contract or (b) fails to certify to the Contractor that the subcontractor will not knowingly employ or contract with an illegal alien to perform work under this Contract. [CRS 8-17.5-102(2)(a)(l) & (II).]
- 2. VERIFICATION REGARDING ILLEGAL ALIENS: Contractor has verified or attempted to verify through participation in the basic pilot program of the United States Government that Contractor does not employ any illegal aliens or Contractor verifies that Contractor has not been accepted into the basic pilot program prior to entering into this Contract. Contractor further verifies that if Contractor has not been accepted in to the basic pilot program of the United States Government, Contractor will apply to participate in the basic pilot program of the United States Government every three months until Contractor is accepted or this Contract is completed, whichever is earlier. [CRS 8-17.5-102(2)(b)(I).]
- 3. LIMITATION REGARDING BASIC PILOT PROGRAM: Contractor shall not use basic pilot program procedures to undertake preemployment screening of job applicants while performing this Contract. CRS 8-17.5-102(2)(b)(II).]
- 4. DUTY TO TERMINATE A SUBCONTRACT; EXCEPTIONS: If Contractor obtains actual knowledge that a subcontractor performing work under this Contract knowingly employs or contracts with an illegal alien, the Contractor shall, unless the subcontractor provides information to establish that the subcontractor has not knowingly employed or contracted with an illegal alien:
 - (a) notify the subcontractor and the City within three days that the Contractor has actual knowledge that the subcontractor is employing or contracting with an illegal alien; and
 - (b) terminate the subcontract with the subcontractor if, within three days of receiving notice that the Contractor has actual knowledge that the subcontractor is employing or contracting with an illegal alien, the subcontractor does not stop employing or contracting with the illegal alien. CRS 8-17.5-102(2)(b)(III)(A) & (B).]

- 5. DUTY TO COMPLY WITH STATE INVESTIGATION: Contractor shall comply with any reasonable request of the Colorado Department of Labor and Employment made in the course of an investigation pursuant to C.R.S. 8-17.5-102 (5). CRS 8-17.5-102(2)(b)(IV).]
- 6. DAMAGES FOR BREACH OF CONTRACT: In addition to any other legal or equitable remedy the City may be entitled to for a breach of this Contract, if the City terminates this Contract, in whole or in part, due to Contractor's breach of any paragraph numbered one (1) through five (5) inclusive, Contractor shall be liable for actual and consequential damages to the City.
