SUBJECT: Alcohol at Pool Facilities CB-1781

RECOMMENDATION

Staff brings forward the attached Ordinance, amending section 18-2-8.5 9(b) of the Municipal Code, as per the recommendation of the Parks and Recreation Advisory Board. This amendment would restrict the issuance of Special Occasion Permits from park facilities that include a swimming pool. The Parks and Recreation Advisory Board unanimously supports this amendment.

BACKGROUND

This year, a Special Occasion Permit application was submitted for Kiwanis Pool. The application was eventually withdrawn, as other requirements of the permitting process could not be met by the applicant. Staff had safety concerns regarding the use of alcohol at any pool facility, and sought input from the Parks and Recreation Advisory Board. The board felt strongly that alcohol should not be allowed in pool facilities.

Staff believes that this Ordinance change would allow for Special Private Occasion Permits to be issued for events taking place in the general purpose rooms at the Recreation Center, as is currently permitted, but will not be allowed for an event occurring in either the indoor swimming pool or Kiwanis pool.

TIME/BUDGET IMPLICATIONS

There are no budget or time implications associated with this amendment.
