A RESOLUTION TO COMPENSATE TEMPORARY EMPLOYEES OF THE CITY COUNCIL ACTING IN A TEMPORARY OR INTERIM CAPACITY

WHEREAS, the City Council desires to set a policy regarding the compensation of City Council employees, specifically the City Manager and the City Clerk, who act in a temporary or acting capacity for a period in excess of two (2) weeks; and

WHEREAS, the City Council wishes to avoid the retroactive payment of such amounts by setting such a policy in advance.

BE IT RESOLVED BY THE CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF NORTHGLENN, COLORADO, THAT:

Section 1. The City Council hereby determines that in the event there is a need for an Acting or Interim City Manager or Acting or Interim City Clerk appointed by the City Council for a period in excess of two (2) weeks, that the City Council shall appoint such a person by Resolution and shall immediately, and no later than fifteen (15) days after said appointment, determine an appropriate amount of extra compensation to be paid to any such temporary or acting City Council employee.
