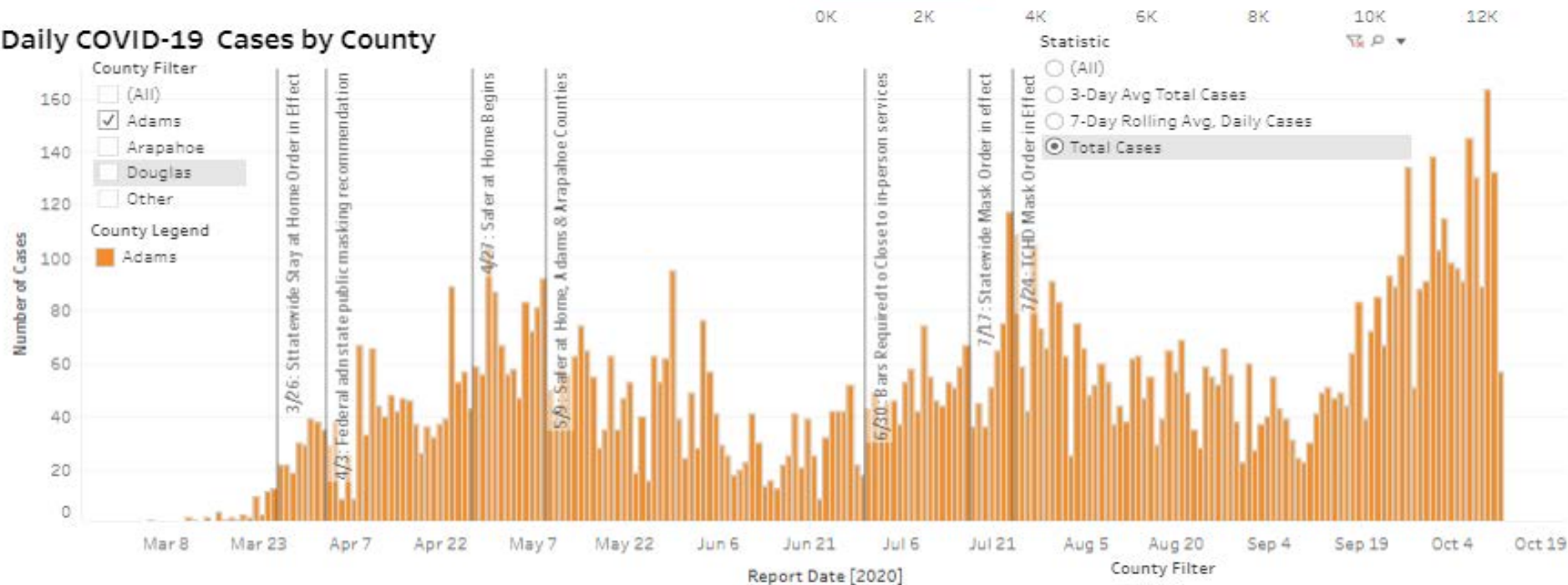

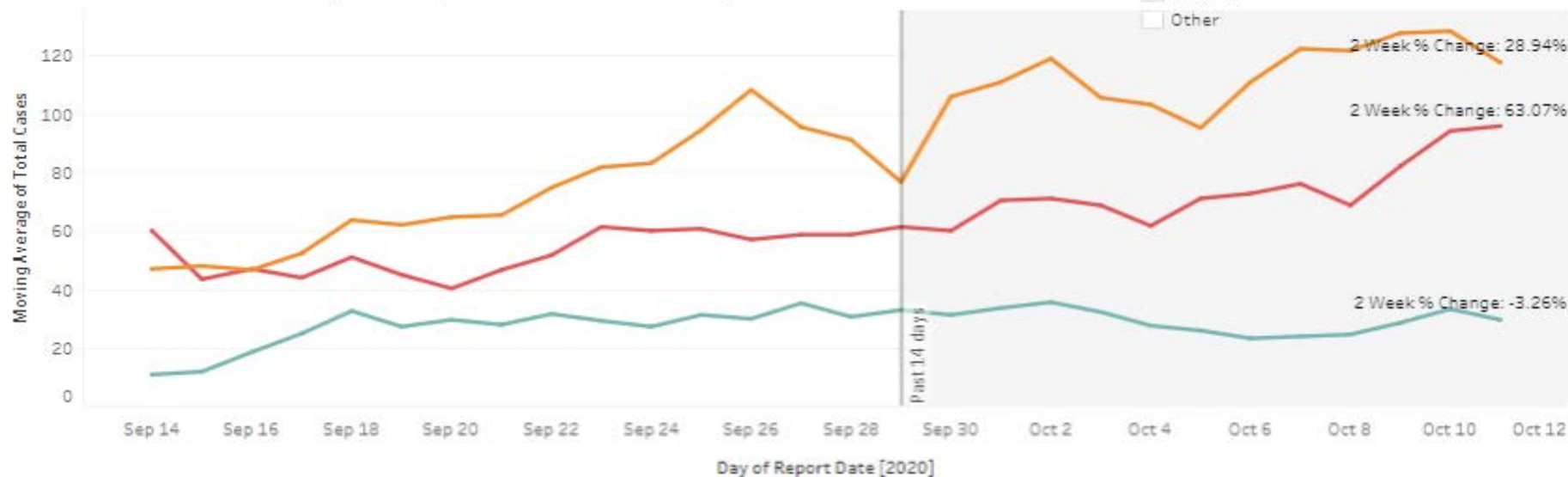


## 3-Day Rolling Average of Positive COVID-19 Cases, Past 28 Days

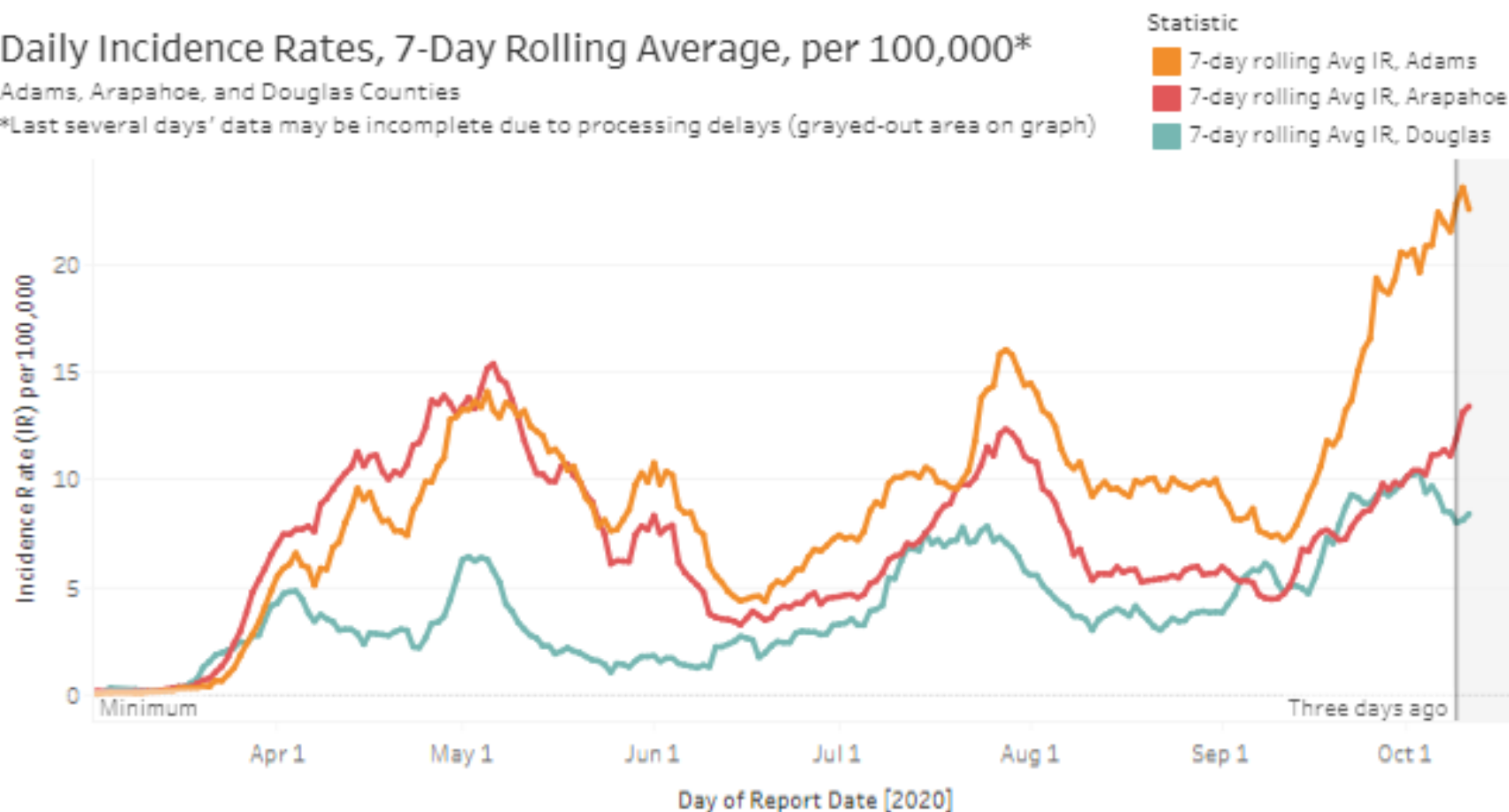

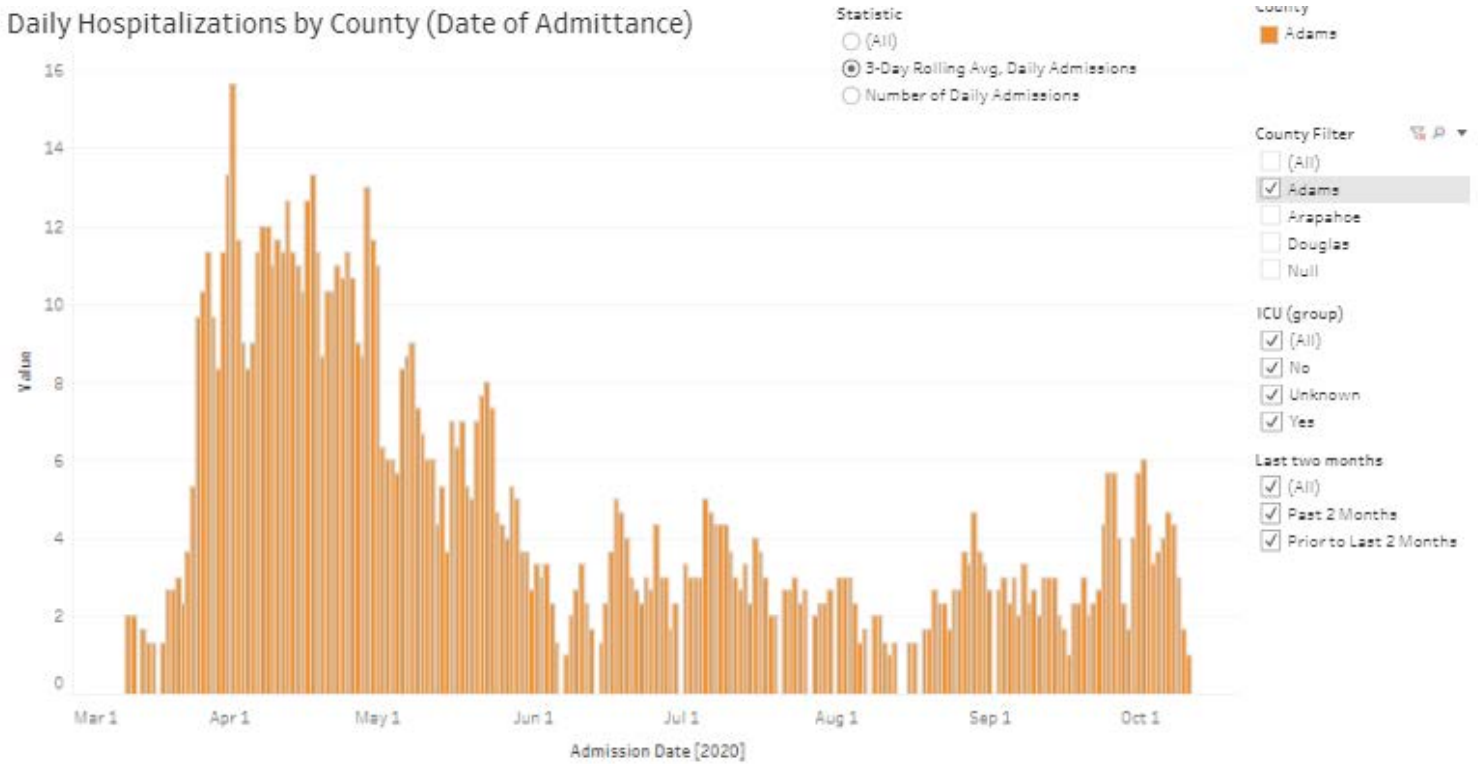

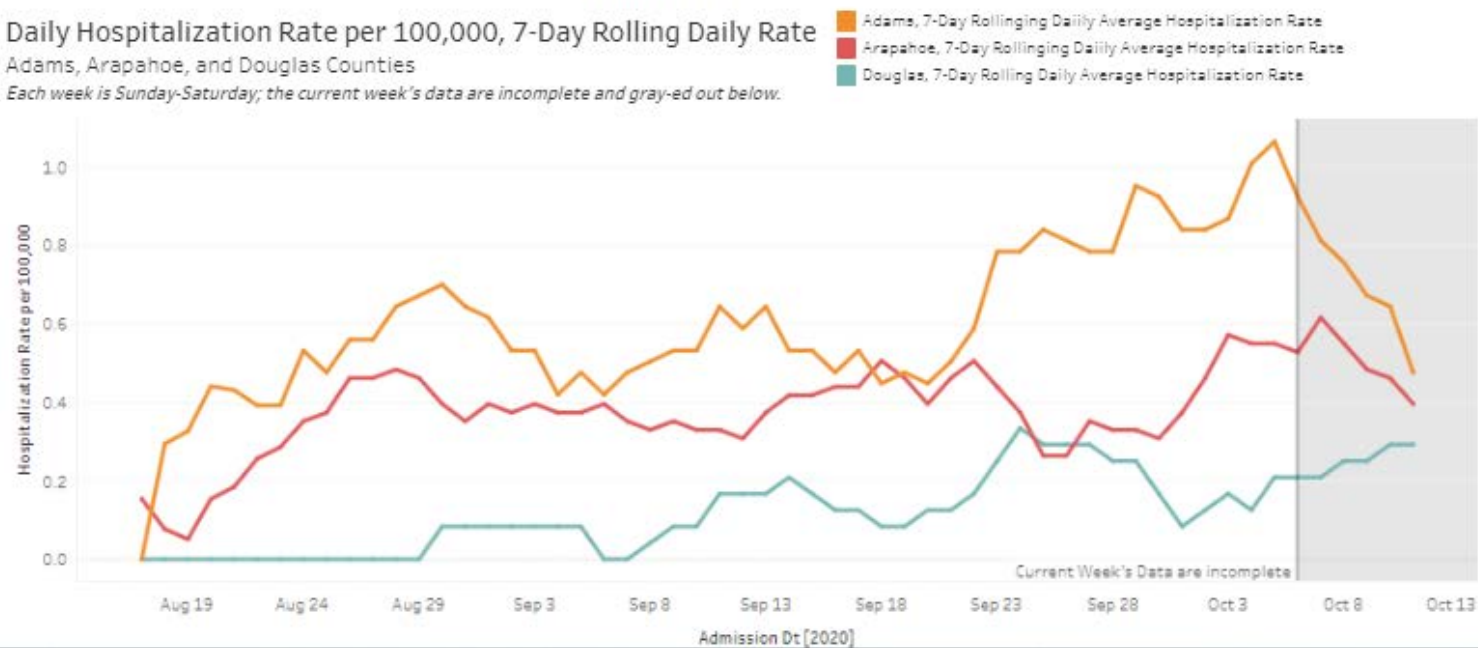
### Daily Hospitalizations by County (Date of Admittance)

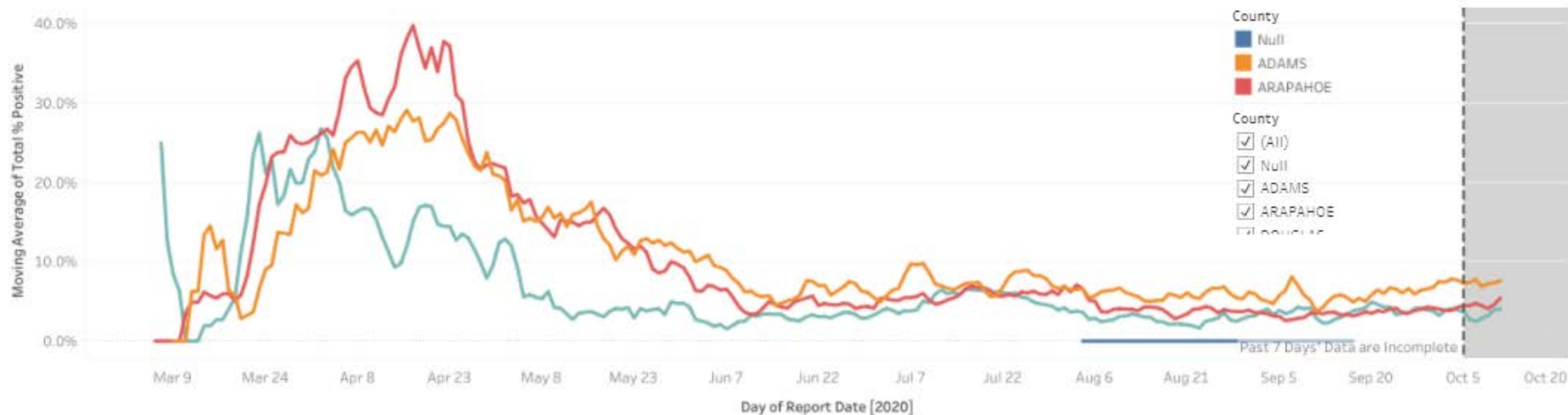

\*\*This trend is updated daily. The number represented by the last data point may be incomplete



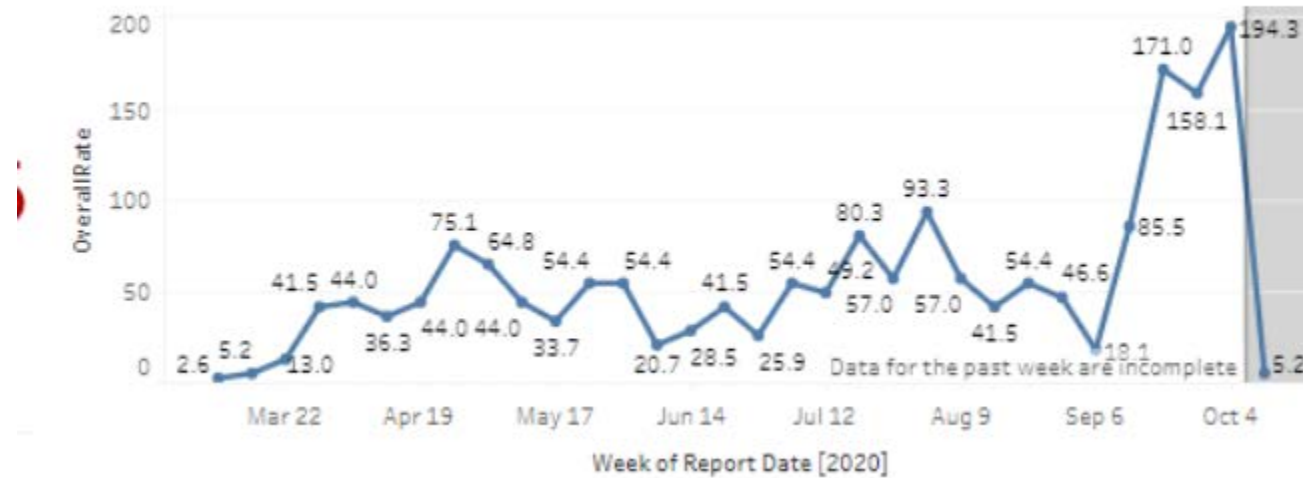
## Daily Number of COVID-19 Hospitalizations (at start of case investigation)

Weekly Incidence Rates, per 100,000

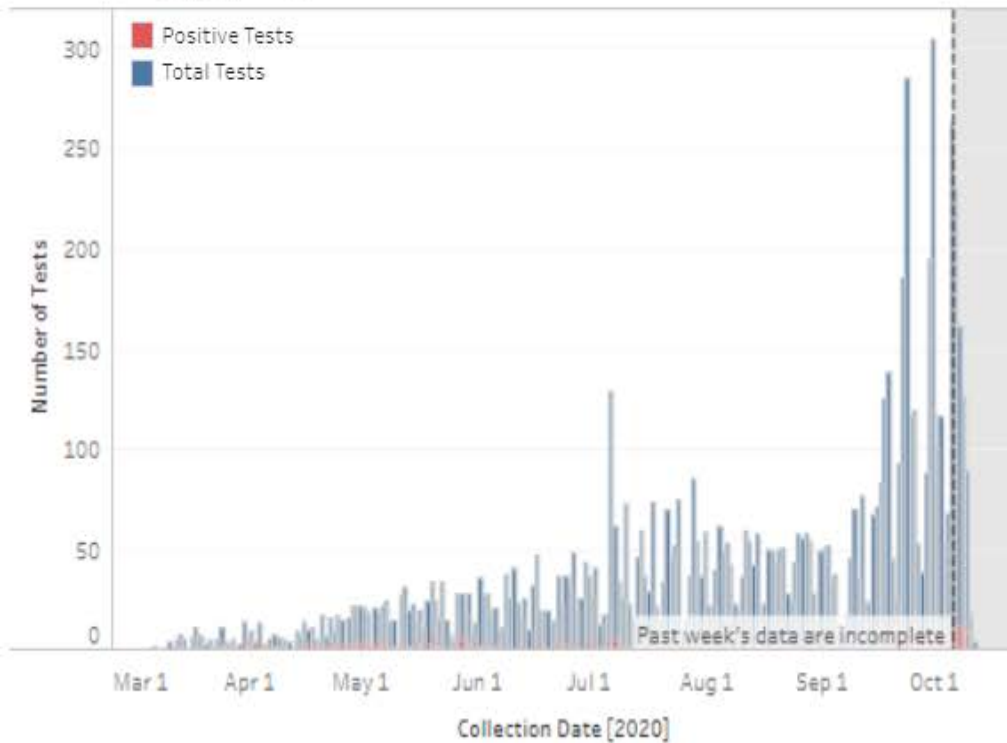

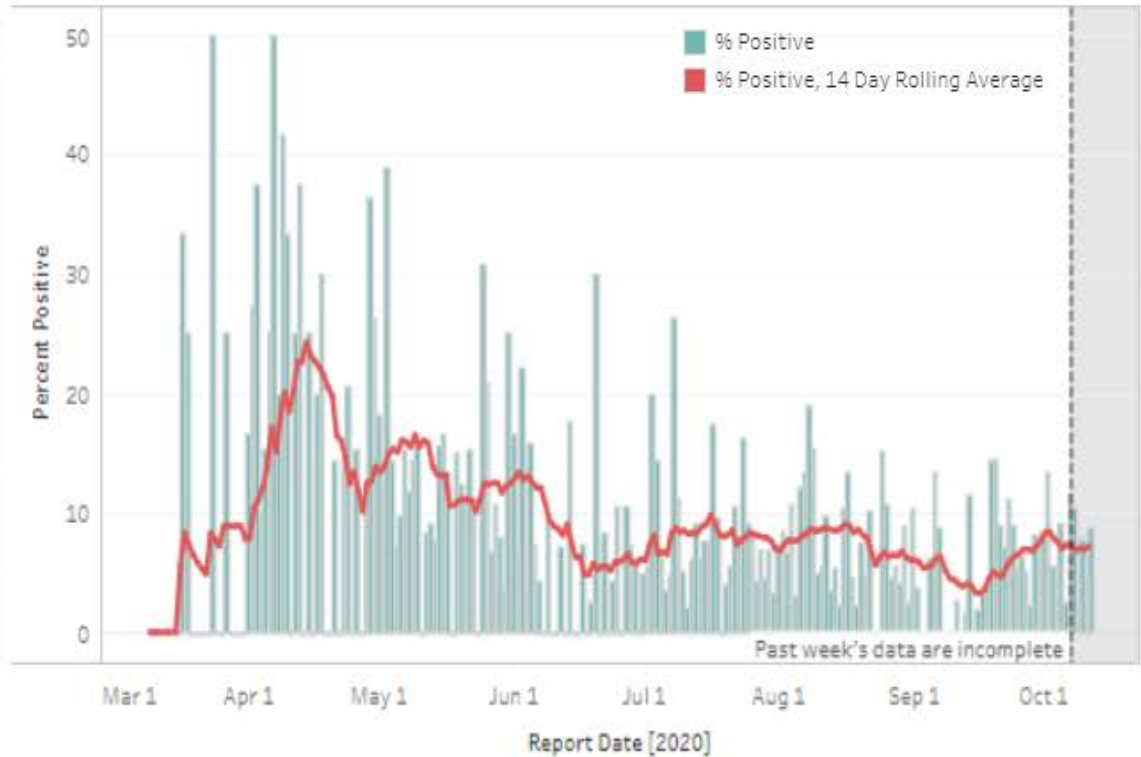

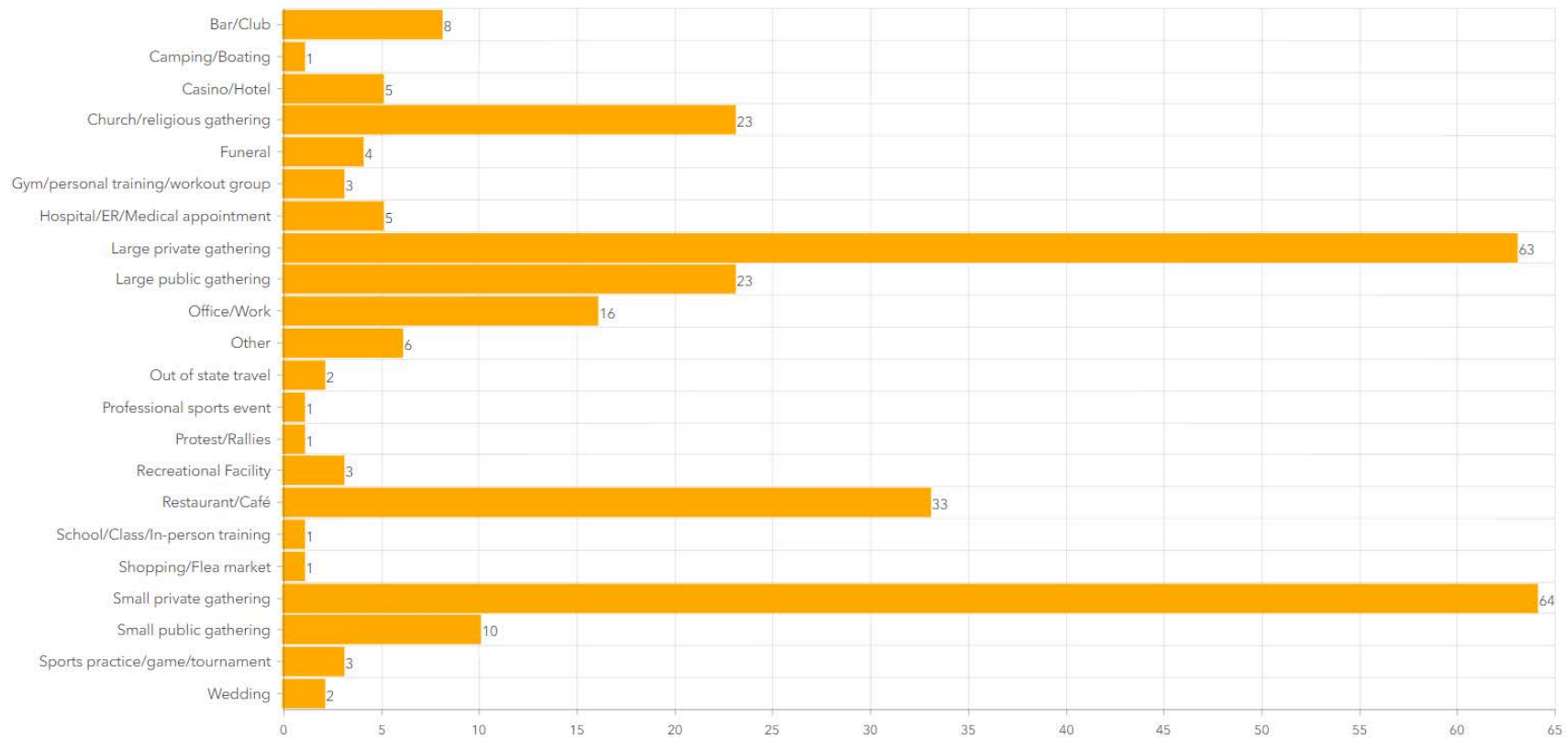
## Percent Positive Tests: Daily and 14-Day Rolling Average

Reported Interactions Prior to Infectious Period



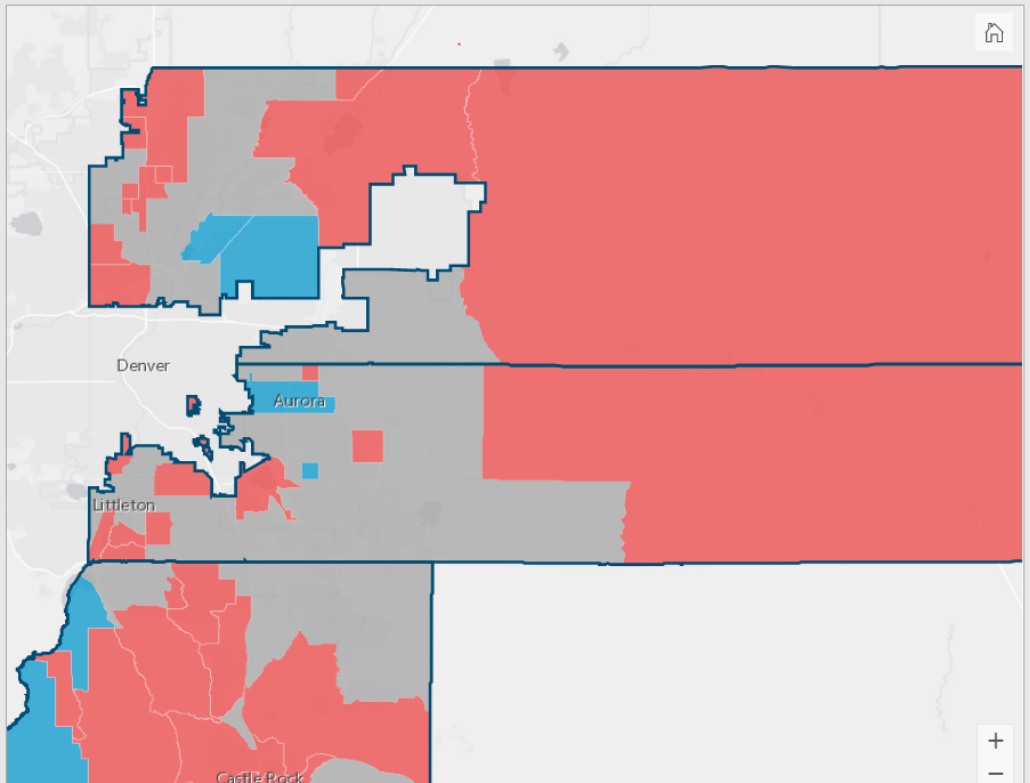

 Safer at Home Level 3: High Risk (175-350 cases /100,000)

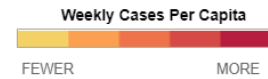
