Capital Equipment (2016) Purchases

BACKGROUND

The 2016 Public Works Department budget identifies Capital Equipment purchases within two funds: Water/Wastewater Fund (W/WWF) and the Sanitation Fund (SF). The table below shows capital equipment that can be purchased directly from an approved vender organization. A definition sheet listing the three vendor/bidding contracts is attached to this memorandum for Council reference. The equipment requests are replacements and consistent with the applicable 2016 Pro Forma.

BUDGET/TIME IMPLICATIONS

The 2016 Water/Wastewater Fund – Public Works Distribution and Collection Division, Capital Equipment account identifies an appropriation of \$280,000 for the equipment replacements listed in the table shown above. The bid cost for this equipment is \$252,394.

Likewise, the Sanitation Fund – Public Works Sanitation Capital Equipment account shows an appropriation of \$330,000 for the equipment replacements listed in the table shown above. The bid cost for this equipment is \$326,097.

RECOMMENDATION

Attached to this memorandum is a Resolution that, if approved, would allow the City Manager to issue a Purchase Order to the approved vendors as itemized in the amounts shown in the table. These 2016 Capital
