A RESOLUTION IN SUPPORT OF THE NORTHGLENN POLICE DEPARTMENT AND LAW ENFORCEMENT OFFICERS NATIONWIDE

WHEREAS, the men and women of the City of Northglenn Police Department and all of our nation's law enforcement agencies wear their uniforms with honor, dedication, and integrity as they protect and serve their communities;

WHEREAS, these uniforms have made them targets by those who seek to kill or injure law enforcement officers simply because of their profession and commitment to duty. Since 2012, eleven (11) Northglenn officers have been involved in shootings with three of them being wounded. During this same time, an additional thirty four (34) officers have been injured in interactions with suspects;

WHEREAS, the national law enforcement family mourns the continuing loss of the many officers that have fallen victim to these vicious attacks:

WHEREAS, the members of the Northglenn City Council and the citizens of Northglenn, Colorado stand with the families of the fallen, and the officers currently protecting our community and the officers throughout the United States; and

WHEREAS, the Northglenn City Council agrees with National Fraternal Order of Police, who has called on the Executive Branch of the Federal Government to acknowledge this crisis and asked them to work to address the violent surge against police by expanding the federal hate crimes law to protect police, to reauthorize the Bulletproof Vest Partnership Program, and to fully fund the state and local law enforcement assistance programs that provide our men and women in the field with the resources and equipment they need to do their jobs and get home to their families at the end of their shift.

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED BY THE CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF NORTHGLENN, COLORADO, THAT:

<u>Section 1</u>. The City Council of the City of Northglenn stands together with our City of Northglenn Police Officers and officers nationwide. Together we are united. "Fortes in Unitate"-"Strength in Unity."
