A BILL FOR AN ORDINANCE AMENDING THE NORTHGLENN ZONING ORDINANCE REGARDING THE KEEPING OF CHICKENS AND BEES IN RESIDENTIAL ZONES

BE IT ORDAINED BY THE CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF NORTHGLENN, COLORADO, THAT:


Section 1. Section 11-7-2, subsection (g) of the Northglenn Municipal Code is amended to read as follows:

**Section 11-7-2.** Restrictions. The following restrictions shall apply in all residential zones of the City:

\* \* \*

(g) The keeping of ~~ehickens~~, ducks, geese and other poultry (EXCLUDING CHICKENS), cattle, horses, mules, goats, sheep, pigs, hooved animals and other domestic or bovine animals, other than birds kept indoors as pets is prohibited. The keeping of dogs, cats, RABBITS, CHICKENS, BEES and certain other pets is permitted and is governed by Chapter 14 of this Code.


