COLORADO, THAT: Section 1. Section 11-7-2, subsection (g) of the Northglenn Municipal Code is amended to read as follows: Section 11-7-2. Restrictions. The following restrictions shall apply in all residential zones of the City: (g) The keeping of chickens, ducks, geese and other poultry (EXCLUDING CHICKENS), cattle, horses, mules, goats, sheep, pigs, hooved animals and other domestic or bovine animals, other than birds kept indoors as pets is prohibited.
