2008 Community Development Block Grant Program

On August 23, 2007, the City Council of the City of Northglenn, Colorado will hold a public hearing on the use of the City's 2008 Community Development Block Grant (CDBG) funding. The public hearing will be held during the City Council meeting that will begin at 7:00 p.m. in City Hall Council Chambers, 11701 Community Center Drive.

Approximately \$200,000.00 is anticipated to be available to the City for eligible projects during 2008. Anyone who would like to address City Council concerning possible projects for 2008 is invited to attend the public hearing.

In order to be eligible for funding, projects must address one of the following national objectives:

- 1. The activity principally benefits low/moderate income residents;
- 2. The activity aids in the prevention or elimination of slums or blight;
- 3. The activity addresses urgent community development needs such as a situation declared a national emergency.

The program is not intended to replace local funding for routine governmental services or for community development activities already being funded locally. It is proposed that approximately \$200,000 of the City's 2008 CDBG funding should be used to fund the "Building Northglenn Neighborhoods Initiative".
