

## **PROCLAMATION**

WHEREAS, the President of the United States, Congress and the General Assembly of the

State of Colorado have designated May  $15^{th}$  as National Peace Officers' Memorial Day, and the week of May  $9^{th}$  through  $15^{th}$  as National Law

Enforcement Memorial Week; and

WHEREAS, during Law Enforcement Memorial Week, and in particular on Peace Officers'

Memorial Day, we honor those officers who made the ultimate sacrifice while

performing their sworn duty; and

WHEREAS, due to the COVID-19 pandemic, events and gatherings planned for National

Law Enforcement Memorial Week and Peace Officers' Memorial Day were postponed and the National Law Enforcement Memorial established Police Weekend in October to provide the appropriate time and memorial events to

honor the nation's Roll Call of Heroes; and

WHEREAS, in 2020, 295 law enforcement officers were killed in the line of duty in the

United States. Three officers were killed in the line of duty in Colorado: Detective Curt Michael Holland, Commerce City Police Department; Deputy Sheriff Jeffrey Christopher Hopkins, El Paso County Sheriff's Office; and Ranger Brendan Patrick Unitt, Larimer County Department of Natural

Resources; and

WHEREAS, the Northglenn Police Department tragically lost one of their own officers,

Corporal Edgar "E.B." Rains Jr., who was killed in the line of duty 37 years ago

on May 30th, 1984; and

**WHEREAS**, it is fitting and appropriate for all residents to join together in commemorating

law enforcement officers, past and present, who by their faithful and loyal devotion to their responsibilities have rendered a dedicated service to their

community, helping to preserve the rights and security of all residents.

NOW THEREFORE, I, Meredith Leighty, Mayor of the City of Northglenn, Colorado, do hereby

proclaim October 13<sup>th</sup> through 17<sup>th</sup>, 2021 as **National Police Weekend** in the City of Northglenn in observance of **National Law Enforcement Memorial Week** 

and National Peace Officers' Memorial Day to honor those law enforcement

officers who, through their courageous deeds, have made the ultimate sacrifice in service to

their communities.
