BE IT ORDAINED BY THE CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF NORTHGLENN, COLORADO, THAT

Section 1. Section 14-3-8 of the Northglenn Municipal Code is hereby amended by the addition of a new subsection (h), which shall read as follows:

**Section 14-3-8.**      Unlawful Acts.

...

(h) It shall be unlawful for a family to keep or possess a combination of more than a total of four (4) dogs or cats at any one time with the exception that one litter of puppies or kittens aged thirteen (13) weeks or younger shall be permitted over and above that limit once per calendar year. For purposes of this section, "family" shall have the meaning given in Article 5, Chapter 11, of this Code.
