A BILL FOR AN EMERGENCY ORDINANCE REPEALING ORDINANCE NO. 1483, SERIES OF 2007, AND DECLARING AN EMERGENCY

WHEREAS, the City Council on April 12, 2007, finally approved Ordinance No. 1483, Series of 2007 ("Ordinance No. 1483"), which required that trash containers be stored so as not to be visible from the public right-of-way;

WHEREAS, Section 3 of Ordinance No. 1483, provided that the effective date of the Ordinance was to be August 1, 2007;

WHEREAS, the City Council has previously determined to seek to have the City's trash collection service be fully automated in the near future, and Ordinance No. 1483 was in part intended as an incremental step in the direction of full automation of the City's trash collection service;

WHEREAS, the City Council now desires to revisit the issue of fully automated trash service in a more comprehensive manner, and therefore desires to repeal Ordinance No. 1483; and

WHEREAS, because Ordinance No. 1483 is to go into effect on August 1, 2007, it is necessary that the repeal of Ordinance No. 1483 be by emergency ordinance pursuant to Section 4.11 of the City of Northglenn Home Rule Charter.

BE IT ORDAINED BY THE CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF NORTHGLENN, COLORADO, THAT:

<u>Section 1.</u> Ordinance No. 1483, Series of 2007, is hereby repealed in its entirety.

<u>Section 2.</u> <u>Emergency</u>. The City Council finds and determines that this Ordinance is necessary for the immediate preservation of public property, health, peace, or safety because Ordinance No. 1483 would otherwise go into effect on August 1, 2007, and therefore, it is necessary for the preservation of public property, health, peace and safety that the status quo will be preserved pending publication of the Ordinance. Accordingly, pursuant to Section 4.11 of the Northglenn City Charter, this Ordinance shall take effect immediately upon enactment.
