## A BILL FOR AN ORDINANCE AMENDING ARTICLE 9 OF CHAPTER 16 REGARDING MEMBERSHIP ON THE NORTHGLENN HISTORIC PRESERVATION COMMISSION

## BE IT ORDAINED BY THE CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF NORTHGLENN, COLORADO, THAT:

Section 1. Section 16-9-4 of the Northglenn Municipal Code is repealed and reenacted to read as follows:

Section 16-9-4. Historic Preservation Commission Established.
(a) There is hereby created a Historic Preservation Commission which shall have principal responsibility for matters of historic preservation as set forth in this Article.
(b) The Commission shall consist of NO LESS THAN seven (7) members,all residents of the City, who shall be appointed by the City Council.
(c) The members shall serve three (3) year staggered terms from the date of appointment. To stagger the initial terms of membership, the original Commission shall consist of: two (2) members to serve one (1) year terms; two (2) members to serve two (2) year terms; and three (3) members to serve three (3) year terms.
(d) A member may serve only two (2) consecutive terms. Appointments to fill vacancies shall be made by the City council.
(ed) All members shall serve without compensation, except for such amounts determined appropriate by the City Council to offset expenses incurred in performance of their duties.
(fe) Members may be removed for cause by the City Council.
(gf) The Commission shall, by majority vote, elect one (1) of its members to serve as chairperson to preside over the meetings, and one (1) member to serve as vice-chairperson. The members so designated shall serve in these capacities for terms of one (1) year, and may serve successive terms.
(łg) The Commission shall, by majority vote, elect one (1) of its members to serve as secretary. The secretary shall take minutes of each meeting, be responsible for publication and
distribution of copies of the minutes, reports, and decisions of the Commission to its members, and give notice as provided by law of all public hearings conducted by the Commission.
(ih) The City Council shall also appoint two (2) alternate members who shall have the same qualifications provided for by this Section 16-9-4
