A RESOLUTION DETERMINING TO CONDUCT CITY COUNCIL MEETINGS VIRTUALLY THROUGH THE END OF FEBRUARY 2022 BASED ON THE CURRENT COVID-19 TRANSMISSION RATE IN ADAMS COUNTY

WHEREAS, the current COVID-19 transmission rate (and the COVID-19 positivity rate) in Adams County has increased significantly, and thus the Mayor has determined the high transmission rate constitutes an “Emergency Situation” within the meaning of the City’s Electronic Participation Policy; and

WHEREAS, based on the increase in COVID-19 cases in Adams County, the City Council therefore seeks to temporarily conduct City Council meetings virtually through the end of February 2022.

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED BY THE CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF NORTHGLENN, COLORADO, THAT:

Section 1. The City Council hereby determines to conduct its City Council meetings virtually commencing January 10, 2022, and terminating on February 28, 2022, unless extended by Resolution of the City Council.

Section 2. The meetings in January and February of 2022 shall be conducted virtually based on the temporary significant increase in COVID-19 cases in Adams County, which increase makes in person meetings not practical or prudent because of a health pandemic, which constitutes an Emergency Situation as defined by the City’s Electronic Participation Policy.
