SUBJECT: CR-41 – Sport and Fitness Additional Contingency Authorization

PURPOSE

To consider CR-41, requesting authorization for additional contingency in the amount of \$1,272.76 for the contract with Sport and Fitness (S&F) for weight room equipment associated with the Northglenn Civic Center Master Plan Phase I Implementation Project. This additional contingency allows for accommodation of a reduction in trade-in credit and an increase in freight charges.

BACKGROUND

City Council authorized a contract on Jan. 27, 2020 with S&F for the provision of fitness equipment associated with the construction of the new Northglenn Recreation Center, Senior Center and Theatre in the amount of \$198,440.60. During the past two years, equipment was ordered, delivered, and installed by S&F per the initial contract.

UPDATE

During the final delivery and installation process, two modifications to the original scope of work were identified. This includes:

- Retainage of three pieces of equipment found to be in good condition, resulting in a decrease in trade-in credit
- Additional freight charges resulting from global shipping constraints, port delays and increased fuels costs, resulting in an increase in expense

BUDGET/TIME IMPLICATIONS

Funding is available within the overall project contingency. Authorization of the proposed additional contingency in the amount of \$1,272.76 associated with the contract with S&F would not result in an increase to the overall project budget.

STAFF RECOMMENDATION

Attached to this memorandum is CR-41, a resolution that, if approved, would authorize a project contingency of \$1,272.76 and authorize the City Manager to approve changes in the scope of work and execute relevant change orders up to the approved expenditure limit of \$199,713.36. Staff recommends approval of the proposed resolution as presented.
