## A RESOLUTION REPEALING RESOLUTION NO. 22-09, SERIES OF 2022, BASED ON THE IMPROVING COVID-19 TRANSMISSION RATE IN ADAMS COUNTY

WHEREAS, the current COVID-19 transmission rate (and the COVID-19 positivity rate) in Adams County has recently decreased significantly since the adoption of Resolution No. 22-09, Series of 2022, at which the City Council at that time determined to temporarily conduct City Council meetings virtually through the end of February 2022; and

WHEREAS, the City Council now determines to conduct its meetings in person going forward, beginning with those meetings conducted after the effective date of this Resolution, February 14, 2022.

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED BY THE CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF NORTHGLENN, COLORADO, THAT:

Section 1. The City Council hereby determines to repeal in part Resolution No. 22-09, Series of 2022 as set forth in Section 2 of this Resolution.

<u>Section 2</u>. The meetings of the City Council conducted after February 14, 2022 shall be conducted in person, and the City Council finds and determines that the Emergency Situation which necessitated virtual meetings as defined by the City's Electronic Participation Policy is no longer in existence because the COVID-19 transmission rate (and the COVID-19 positivity rate) has improved significantly enough to allow in person meetings going forward.
