STAFF ANALYSIS

- **Application is complete**
- **All fees have been paid**
- **Sandra Petersen Young, sole managing member of Young Ventures USA, LLC, submitted to a background investigation disclosing no record of arrest or conviction**
- **A similar transfer of ownership application was filed in 2021 where the sole managing member of Young Ventures USA, LLC was listed as Gary Young, Sandra Petersen Young's spouse**



STAFF ANALYSIS

- **Gary Young submitted to a background investigation disclosing potential disqualifying factors**
- **The previous transfer of ownership application was withdrawn prior to a public hearing with the Authority**
- **Staff is unable to administratively approve the current application due to the following:**
 - § The extent of Gary Young's involvement is not clear
 - § The eligibility of Gary Young to hold a retail marijuana license has not been formally determined by the Authority



CRITERIA FOR CONSIDERATION

- **Municipal Code Section 18-16-14 contains criteria for those eligible to hold a retail marijuana license**
- **Full set of criteria is listed in application summary**
- **Staff identified the following criteria as needing the Authority's consideration:**
 - § No retail marijuana business license shall be issued to, held by, or renewed by the following:
 5. Any person employing, assisted by, or financed in whole or in part by any other person who is not of good character and reputation satisfactory to the local licensing authority; and
 11. Any entity whose directors, shareholders, partners or other persons having a financial interest in said entity do not meet the criteria set forth above.



ACTION REQUIRED

- **The Authority may approve the application as presented; or**
- **The Authority may set a public hearing on the application to determine whether the application should be approved or denied**
 - § Before an application can be denied, a public hearing must be held to provide the applicant an opportunity to present evidence and testimony regarding the application
 - § Staff recommends setting a public hearing for May 9, 2022



NEXT STEPS

- **If the Authority approves the application as presented, the transfer of ownership may be finalized by the applicant upon approval by the State Marijuana Enforcement Division**
- **If the Authority sets a public hearing on the application, the applicant will receive notice of the date and time of the hearing. A notice will also be posted on the licensed premises at least 10 days prior to the hearing.**
