SUBJECT: CB-1985 – Amendment to the Harassment Section of the Municipal Code

PURPOSE

To consider CB-1985, an ordinance on second reading that would amend Section 9-4-4, Subsection (a) of the Municipal Code regarding harassment. It would strike "intended to harass" from the code to be in compliance with the recent Colorado Supreme Court ruling that is prompting this change.

BACKGROUND

In *People v. Moreno* (2022), the Colorado Supreme Court ruled that the State "harassment statute" was unconstitutional since it restricts protected speech. Rather than invalidating the entire harassment statute, the Colorado Supreme Court struck the phrase "intended to harass."

The Municipal Code currently has the "intended to harass" phrase in its harassment code and needs to be modified as a result of the *Moreno* ruling.

Council also received a confidential memo from City Attorney Corey Hoffmann recommending this proposed ordinance.

BUDGET/TIME IMPLICATIONS

There are no financial or time impacts to the City.

STAFF RECOMMENDATION

Staff recommends approval of CB-1985 on second reading.
