Interim Financial Statements For the Period Ending October 2017

Executive Summary:

Sales/Use Tax

 Year-to-date sales and use tax reported an increase of \$527,442, or 3.3%, when compared to the previous year.

General Fund

- Year-to-date revenues within the General Fund total \$19,957,246, remaining essentially unchanged when compared to the prior year. Revenue collection differences from the prior year were caused from the timing of receipts.
- General Fund year-to-date expenditures total \$18,582,175 accounting for 72% of the annual appropriation. Expenditures within the fund have increased approximately 2.6% or \$463,939 over the prior year.

Water and Wastewater Fund

- Water & Wastewater Fund year-to-date revenues total \$11,675,903. This is a decrease of approximately 1.3% as compared to the prior year. Revenues restricted for water resources are \$48,955 or 2.5%, more than in the prior year. The restricted revenue for debt service is up approximately 5%, or \$34,336.
- Year-to-date expenditures within the Water & Wastewater Fund total \$12,582,041 and account for 63% of the annual appropriation. Fund expenditures increased \$2,215,930 or 21% when compared to the same period of 2016.

Stormwater Fund

- Year-to-date revenues within the Stormwater Fund total \$339,960, an increase over last year's collections by 2% or \$5,828.
- Stormwater Fund year-to-date expenditures total \$1,616,896 and account for 102% of the annual appropriation. Fund expenditures increased \$1,474,641 when compared to the same period of 2016.

Sanitation Fund

- Sanitation Fund year-to-date revenues total \$1,506,782, an increase of approximately 23% as compared to the prior year. While a significant portion of the fees associated with sanitation services are assessed at a flat amount and remain extremely consistent, the rate increase approved in 2016 accounts for the increased revenue. The rate increase was approximately 30% for the base rate and fees for other services also increased.
- Year-to-date expenditures within the Sanitation Fund total \$937,252 and account for 50% of the annual appropriation. Expenditures within the fund decreased 27.5% or \$355,213 from the prior year.

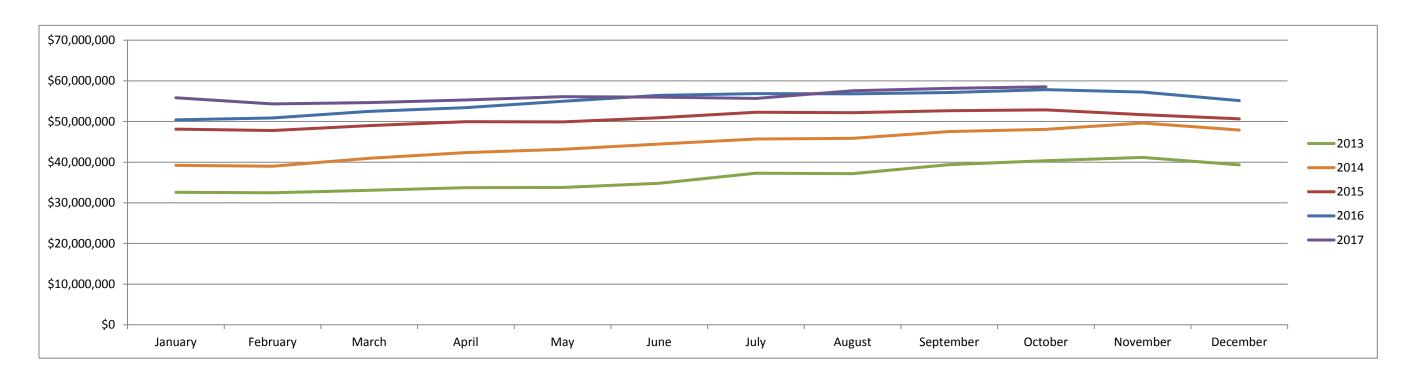

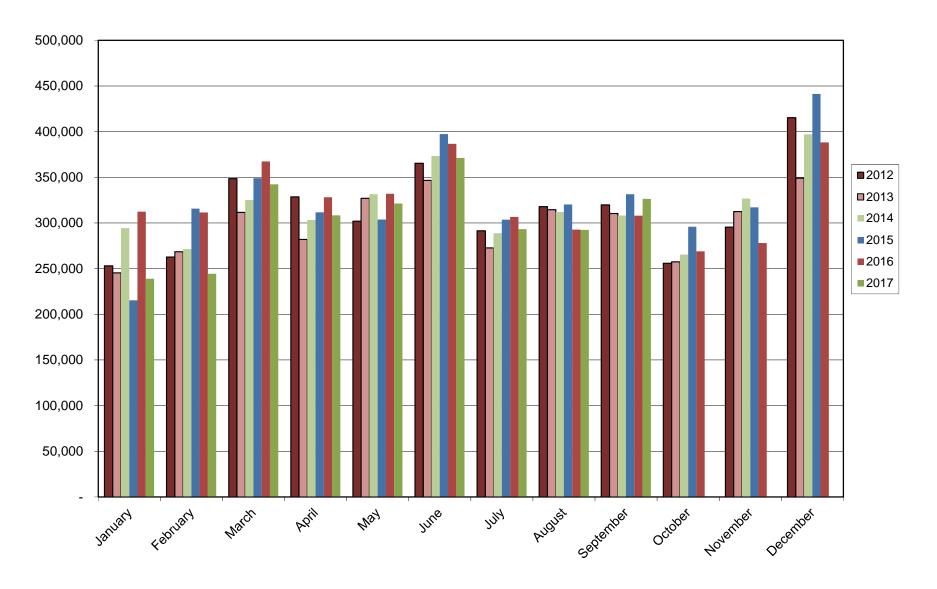

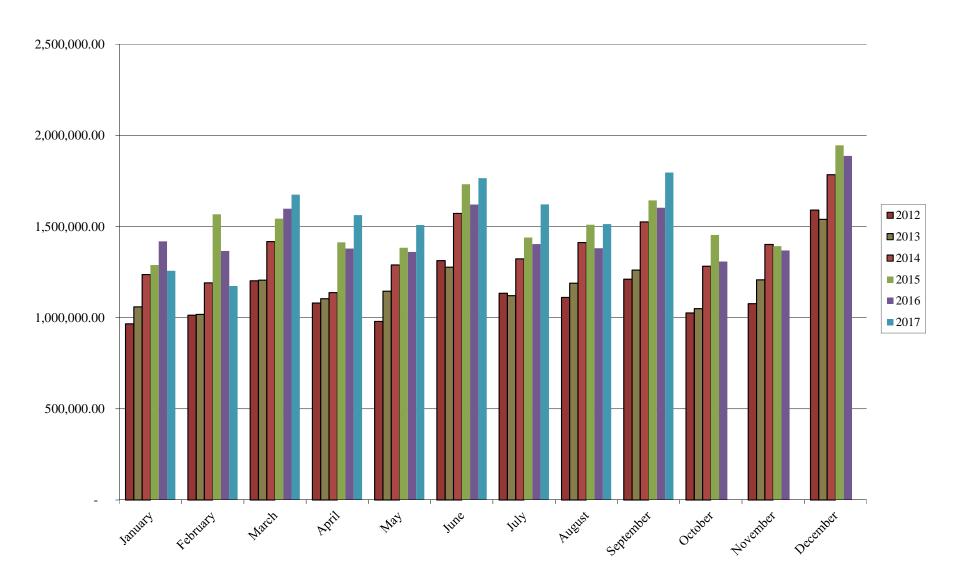
