

PROCLAMATION

- WHEREAS, child abuse and neglect is a serious problem affecting every segment of our community, and preventing child abuse requires input and action from everyone; and
- WHEREAS, the effects of child abuse and neglect are felt by whole communities, and child abuse can have long-term psychological, emotional, and physical effects that have lasting consequences for victims of abuse; and
- **WHEREAS,** one of the most effective ways to prevent child abuse is to strengthen families to ensure safe, stable, nurturing environments for children; and
- WHEREAS, neighbors, community organizations, employers, teachers, people in the service industry, and faith communities can play important roles in providing support to families; and
- WHEREAS, research has shown that child abuse is less likely to occur when parents feel secure and empowered to ask for help and have access to resources in their community; and
- WHEREAS, to end child abuse and neglect, all Coloradoans need to learn about child abuse and neglect and be willing to get involved to help a parent or child in need.

NOW THEREFORE, I, Meredith Leighty, Mayor of the City of Northglenn, Colorado do hereby proclaim the month of April 2023 as:

CHILD ABUSE PREVENTION AND AWARENESS MONTH

in the City of Northglenn and urge all residents to join together to invest in the lives of children, offer a helping hand to parents and families, support organizations who advocate on behalf of children, and increase awareness to recognize and prevent child abuse.
