-July 4<sup>th</sup> concert cancelled three songs in due to weather

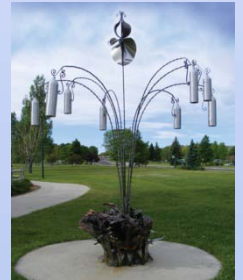


# Northglenn's Art on Parade
