A BILL FOR AN ORDINANCE AMENDING CHAPTER 13 OF THE NORTHGLENN MUNICIPAL CODE BY THE ADDITION OF NEW SECTION 13-1-6 REGARDING STUDENT ELECTION JUDGES

WHEREAS, pursuant to the Uniform Election Code, and specifically C.R.S. § 1-6-101(7), qualified students may be allowed to serve as student election judges; and

WHEREAS, the City has not adopted the Uniform Election Code, but wishes to extend such an opportunity to the qualified students of the City;

NOW THEREFORE BE IT ORDAINED BY THE CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF NORTHGLENN, COLORADO, THAT:

<u>Section 1</u>. Article 1 of Chapter 13 of the Northglenn Municipal Code is hereby amended by the addition of a new Section 13-1-6, which shall read as follows:

Section 13-1-6. <u>Student election judges</u>.

- (a) As used in this Section, "student election judge" means a student who meets the requirements of this Section and who is appointed by the City Clerk for service as an election judge in the City pursuant to this Section.
- (b) The City Clerk may work with schools to identify students willing and able to serve as student election judges. Such schools may submit the names of the students to the City Clerk for appointment as student election judges. Home-schooled students may also apply to the City Clerk for appointment as a student election judge pursuant to this Section.
- (c) From the names submitted, the City Clerk may select one or more students to serve as student election judges for any City election. Each student election judge shall:
- (1) Be a United States citizen and a resident of the City at the time of the election;
 - (2) Be willing to serve;
- (3) Be physically and mentally able to perform and complete the assigned tasks;
