# PURPOSE

# BACKGROUND

The Youth Addiction Awareness Poster Contest was developed in 2023 to address the issue of youth addiction taking place in and around the City of Northglenn and assist the Youth Commission in starting conversations on how to address the issue among youth and their families.




"DRUGS ARE NEVER WORTH IT" BY RIKO BURROWS
