- **WHEREAS**, Black History Month is a time for us all to reflect on and celebrate the significant contributions Black Americans have made to our nation's history, culture, and achievements; and
- **WHEREAS**, the theme for 2024, "African Americans and the Arts," illustrates the extraordinary impact that Black artists, writers, musicians, filmmakers, designers, and other creators have had on the artistic landscape of the United States and the entire world; and
- WHEREAS, art has provided a means for historic preservation, community building, and empowerment for Black Americans for generations. Entire genres and cultural movements would not exist without these artistic expressions, including blues, jazz, gospel, hip-hop, soul food, fashion, Afrofuturism, and many more; and
- **WHEREAS**, by highlighting the arts during Black History Month, we acknowledge the achievements of Black creators who have enriched our lives and communities with extraordinary creativity, innovation, and talent; and
- WHEREAS, locally, Northglenn Arts is celebrating Black artists in February with performances at the Parsons Theatre by Mary Louise Lee and Robert Johnson, Dasha Kelly Hamilton, and the Cleo Parker Robinson Dance Company; and
- **WHEREAS**, Black History Month provides an opportunity for our community to honor the legacy of Black artists, past and present, who have used their platforms to challenge stereotypes, advocate for social justice, and promote unity and understanding through art; and
- **WHEREAS**, the City of Northglenn is committed to advancing racial justice and equity; we seek to promote cultural awareness, inspire dialogue, and build bridges that strengthen the bonds of our diverse community.
