SUBJECT: CR-72 – Adams County St. Patrick’s Day Weekend DUI Saturation Patrols

PURPOSE

To consider CR-72, a resolution approving a Mutual Aid Agreement between the City and the Adams County Sheriff’s Office (ACSO) to provide officers and equipment on March 16 and 17, 2024, to conduct driving under the influence (DUI) saturation patrols within Adams County.

BACKGROUND

On an annual basis, the Adams County Sheriff’s Office asks the Brighton Police Department, Northglenn Police Department (NPD), Commerce City Police Department, Thornton Police Department, and Westminster Police Department to provide mutual aid during the St. Patrick’s Day holiday DUI saturation patrols.

Through Colorado Revised Statute Section 29-5-103, officers and equipment from the Northglenn Police Department would be temporarily assigned to the ACSO. The requested patrols would run from 4 p.m. Saturday, March 16, to 2 a.m. Sunday, March 17, or until the duties associated with this temporary assignment are complete.

All law enforcement officers assigned to the operation would be under the immediate command of their agency’s personnel.

BUDGET/TIME IMPLICATIONS

The cost associated with one officer working the DUI saturation patrol is \$764.80 each day. The total cost of both days of DUI saturation patrol is estimated at \$1,680 for the department. These funds are included in NPD’s 2024 budget.

STAFF RECOMMENDATION

Staff recommends approval of CR-72.
