



PROCLAMATION

WHEREAS, the Sock It To Em sock campaign has strived every year since 2011 to raise awareness for the homeless throughout the winter months and gather donations of new and gently used socks to warm the feet of those without shelter; and

WHEREAS, 2015 marks the fourth annual Sock It To Em sock campaign and Sock It To Em Work Day, where Colorado communities are asked to forgo their socks and support the homeless as a show of solidarity; and

WHEREAS, those who participate in the Sock It To Em sock campaign are encouraged to post pictures of themselves on the campaign's Facebook page sporting bare feet and ankles in order to help raise awareness of the cause and help encourage others to donate warm comfort to those in need; and

WHEREAS, the Sock It To Em sock campaign is a joint effort of volunteers and local businesses who have a goal of providing socks to 50,000 fellow Coloradans in need this winter; and

WHEREAS, the Sock It To Em sock campaign encourages communities, schools, and organizations to adopt the day or week and start their own sock campaign throughout the winter months to raise awareness and lend a helping hand.

NOW, THEREFORE, I, Joyce Downing, Mayor of the City of Northglenn, Colorado, do hereby proclaim December 9, 2015 as:
