WHEREAS, children who play are healthier and suffer less obesity and obesity-related health problems such as diabetes and heart disease; and

WHEREAS, children who play do better in school and develop cognitive skills that are linked to learning and academic performance; and

WHEREAS, children who play learn the social skills that help them become happy and well-adjusted adults; and

WHEREAS, we encourage everyone in the community – adults, parents, schools, nonprofit organizations, businesses, churches, and all interested parties to raise this community's awareness about play, and to help raise this community's children to become healthy, happy and successful adults; and

WHEREAS, all citizens will be encouraged to continue to support and maintain playspaces and playgrounds for the well-being of this and future generations; and

WHEREAS, on July 4th, spend time playing with your family, in your neighborhood, at the July 4th Family Festival or in a local park. Special "Play Day" activities will be held on July 4th and everyone is invited to join in; and
