- WHEREAS,** the City of Northglenn is committed to ensuring the health, safety, and well-being of all students, educators, staff, and families in every learning environment; and
- WHEREAS,** school safety encompasses physical security, mental and behavioral health, emergency preparedness, positive school climate, digital safety, and supportive, inclusive practices; and
- WHEREAS,** the City of Northglenn partners with Adams 12 Five Star Schools to provide School Resource Officers who work collaboratively with students, staff, and families to support safety, build trust, and help prevent and respond to incidents; and
- WHEREAS,** safe transportation to and from school is essential to protecting students and families, and requires shared responsibility among drivers, pedestrians, caregivers, school staff, and traffic enforcement; and
