

A RESOLUTION ESTABLISHING DESIGNATED PUBLIC PLACES FOR THE POSTING OF MEETING NOTICES AS REQUIRED BY THE COLORADO OPEN MEETINGS LAW

WHEREAS, Section 24-6-402(2)(c) of the Colorado Revised Statutes, as amended, requires that the public place or places for posting public notices of the meetings of the local public body shall be designated annually at the local public body’s first regular meetings of each calendar year.

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED BY THE LIQUOR LICENSING AUTHORITY OF THE CITY OF NORTHGLENN, COLORADO, THAT:

Section 1. The designated public place for the posting of meeting notices as required by the Colorado Open Meetings Law, C.R.S. § 24-6-402(2)(c), shall be the City Hall Bulletin Board – Lower Level and Upper Level of Northglenn City Hall, 11701 Community Center Drive, Northglenn, Colorado 80233. The City Clerk or her designated deputies shall be responsible for posting the required notices no later than twenty-four (24) hours prior to the holding of the meeting. All meeting notices shall include specific agenda information, where possible.

Section 2. In addition, all notices posted at the places designated above shall be posted on the City’s official website.
