

Northglenn Safety Sensitive Zone Report

July 2026



Enforcement Activity

Patrol officers directed their traffic enforcement efforts toward the City's four Safety Sensitive Zones, high-crash corridors, school zones, and high-crime areas with significant pedestrian and vehicle activity. A total of **275** citations were issued by Patrol officers. The Traffic Team concentrated its enforcement in school zones, high-injury crash locations, speed complaint corridors, and commercial vehicle routes. Their focused efforts resulted in **380** citations issued.



Crash Analysis

This month, **79** crashes were reported citywide. In these crashes, there were **0** instances of a fatality, **2** instances of serious injury, **8** instances of minor injury, **15** instances of possible injury, and **65** instances of no apparent injury. The intersection of **W 104th Ave & Melody Dr** recorded the highest crash volume with **3** incidents. A total of **0** crashes occurred within the designated Safety Sensitive Zones (SSZ) this month. A total of **3** crashes have occurred inside the SSZ YTD.



School Zone

0 school zone citations were issued this month, representing a **0%** change from **0** citations in the prior month. **Year-to-date**, a total of **37** citations have been issued in school zones demonstrating our continued commitment to high-visibility enforcement during school arrival and dismissal periods.
