Mr. Stuart McArthur provided an overview of his background and experience in local government. Mr. McArthur addressed questions from the Council on items including his vision for Northglenn and economic development, strengths and weaknesses, current issues affecting the City, and communication. Mr. McArthur spoke about his objectives and goals as a manager, his view of the manager's involvement in regional organizations, consensus building, management style, and his ability to move the City forward. Mr. McArthur asked Council about the attributes they desire in a manager and expressed his interest in the city manager position.
